CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on our calendar is Case No. -- I'm going to call two cases. So, the first case is Case

No. 21-CMP-00064, Victory Restaurant & Lounge,

License No. 11739, and Case No. -- oh, I'm sorry.

Yes, and Case No. 21-CIT-00031, Victory

Restaurant & Lounge, License No. 117539.

Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate the rights of the parties in Victor Restaurant & Lounge,

please?

MS. FASHBAUGH: Please stand by.
Sidon Yohannes' rights have already been
elevated. Antoine Williams, your rights have
been elevated, and Rhoda Glasgow, your rights
have been elevated. That is all, Mr. Chair.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, thank you. All right, so the first case we're going to address is Case No. 21-CIT-00031, Victor Restaurant & Lounge, License No. 117539. Would the parties please identify themselves for the record, starting with the Government.

7	be accepted. Is there a second?
