3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So,
4 we have now concluded our morning calendar. And
5 since we have completed our morning calendar, let
6 me now do our legal agendas.

7 The first agenda we'll do this
8 morning is our legal agenda alcohol. On the
9 legal agenda alcohol, there are three matters on
10 this agenda.

11 I'll review all three. Then I'll
12 make recommendations. Then I'll call for a vote
13 for the ABC board members to vote to approve the
14 recommendation that was put forth by the Chair
15 for the legal agenda.

16 So, Number 1, review of settlement
17 agreement. This is for Little Beast, License
18 Number 135034. The recommendation is that we
19 will approve the settlement agreement.

20 Number 2, review of a settlement
21 agreement for Annie's Paramount Steaks, License
22 Number 007930. The recommendation is that we
23 approve the settlement agreement.

24 Number 3, it's the review of an Offer
25 in Compromise. This is for Case Number 25-CIT-

1 00091, the Golden Age, License Number 120935.

2 The Offer in Compromise is as follows:

3 Charge 1, failed to file required
4 quarterly statement, second tier violation, D.C.
5 Code section 25-113(b)(2)(A). A warning will be
6 issued and the recommendation is to approve the
7 Offer in Compromise.

8 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
9 board members vote to approve the recommendation
10 as put forth by the Chair for the legal agenda.

11 I'll call. Is there a second?

12 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second the
13 motion.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
15 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
16 vote.

17 Mr. Grant?

18 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

20 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

22 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

24 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

1 Anderson. I agree. The matter passes 5-0.

2 We now move to the legal agenda -
3 alcohol addendum. On this addendum, there are
4 seven matters. Let me read -- I'll go through
5 all seven.

6 Number 1, review of a settlement
7 agreement. This is for Case Number 26-PRO-00012.
8 This is Caspian Crust, License Number 134033.
9 Recommendation approval.

10 Number 2, review of a settlement
11 agreement. This is for Dance Loft on 14th. The
12 License Number is 134344. Recommendation
13 approval.

14 Number 3, review of settlement
15 agreement. This is for Whitlows, License Number
16 082871. Recommendation approval.

17 Number 4, review this amendment into
18 a settlement agreement. This is for MK Lounge U
19 Street. This is in Case Number 25-PRO-00131.
20 The License Number is 131092. Recommendation
21 approval.

22 Number 5, review of settlement
23 agreement. This is for SOST. This is in Case
24 Number 25-PRO-00114, License Number 126215.
25 Recommendation approval.

1 Number 6, review of settlement
2 agreement. This is for Posh, P-O-S-H, Lounge.
3 This is in Case Number 25-PRO-00130. The License
4 Number is 123209. Recommendation approval.

5 Number 7, review of an Offer in
6 Compromise. This is for Case Number 25-CMP-
7 00082, Flirt Cocktail Bar and Social Club,
8 License Number 127493. And the Offer in
9 Compromise is as follows:

10 Charge 1, made a substantial change
11 by operating and offering entertainment outside
12 of approved hours. Statutory authority, D.C.
13 Code Section 25-762. This matter -- this charge
14 is dismissed.

15 Charge 2, operated outside of
16 approved hours. Statutory authority, D.C. Code
17 Section 25-723(b). And there is a fine of \$1,000
18 payable 30 days of the Board accepting the Offer
19 in Compromise. If payment is not made in 30
20 days, the license will be suspended until payment
21 has been made, and the recommendation is to
22 approve.

23 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
24 board members vote to approve the recommendations
25 as put forth by the Chair for the legal agenda -

1 alcohol addendum.

2 Is there a second?

3 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I second.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has
5 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
6 vote.

7 Mr. Grant?

8 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

10 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

12 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

14 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

16 I agree. The matter passed 5-0.

17 We now move to the notice of meeting,
18 legal agenda - medical cannabis. On this agenda,
19 there are five applications and let me review all
20 five.

21 Number 1, review of an Offer in
22 Compromise. This is for Case Number 25-ULC-
23 00057, Sky's the Limit. And the Offer in
24 Compromise is as follows:

25 Number 1, property owner affirms that

1 they have received affirmative confirmation from
2 Sky's the Limit, LLC acknowledging the
3 termination of its lease and intention to vacate
4 the premises as evidenced by Exhibit A.

5 Two, property owner acknowledged that
6 they will provide reasonable cooperation to
7 permit respondent to recover any personal
8 property owned by the respondent that remain on
9 the premises.

10 Number 3, property owner agrees to
11 not lease the premises to Sky's the Limit, LLC
12 nor to lease the premises to; 1, any successor
13 company to Sky's the Limit, or; 2, any unlicensed
14 cannabis establishment for purpose for which a
15 license is required by the district law or
16 regulations at any time in the future.

17 Four, property owner agrees to notify
18 ABCA when it has leased the premises to a new
19 tenant, to provide the identity of the new
20 tenant, include the business name and owner, and
21 permit ABCA to perform an inspection of the
22 premises before the new tenant takes possession
23 of the premises and, therefore, during those
24 hours, if any, that the premises are open to the
25 public.

1 Five, property owner agreed that if a
2 future tenant at the premises, which has not
3 filed an accepted and pending application with
4 the ABC Board, knowingly engages or attempts to
5 engage in the purchase, sale, exchange, delivery,
6 or any other form of commercial transaction
7 involving cannabis for which a license is
8 required by district law or regulation, it shall
9 be grounds for the Board to issue a subsequent
10 notice of summary closure and issue landlord such
11 fines as may be authorized by law.

12 Property owner agrees to waive the
13 notice required set forth in D.C. Code Section 7-
14 1675.01(a), with respect to the instant matter
15 2025-ULC-005.

16 Number 8, The current summary closure
17 shall remain in effect until ABCA makes the keys
18 to the premises available to property owner for
19 pickup at its office or at another mutually
20 agreed-upon time, date, and location.
21 Recommendation for that is approval.

22 Number 2, review motion for
23 reconsideration. This is in Case Number 25-CC-
24 00005, Doobie District, License Number 126751.
25 Recommendation denial.

1 Number 3, review of opposition to
2 motion listed above. This is in Case Number 25-
3 CC-00005, Doobie District, License Number 126751.
4 This is now a recommendation -- this is now moot.

5 Number 4, review of reply to
6 opposition listed above. This is in Case Number
7 25-CC-00005, Doobie District, License Number
8 126751. Recommendation moot.

9 And Number 5, review of motion for
10 reconsideration. This is in Case Number 26-CC-
11 00003, Bud Love, License Number 128413.
12 Recommendation approval.

13 I, therefore, make a motion that the
14 ABC board members vote to approve the
15 recommendation that's set forth by the Chair for
16 the legal agenda - medical cannabis.

17 Is there a second?

18 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I second
19 the motion.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows
21 has seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
22 vote.

23 Mr. Grant?

24 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

1 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

3 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

5 MR. JONES: Jones. I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

7 I agree. The matter passed 5-0.

8 We now move to our legal agenda -
9 medical cannabis addendum. There's one matter on
10 this addendum and it's a review of an Offer and
11 Compromise.

12 This is for Case Number 25-ULC-00077,
13 Flowerz. And the Offer in Compromise is as
14 follows:

15 Number 1, the parties agree that
16 Flowerz, LLC has permanently vacated and
17 terminated its lease of the premises as noted in
18 ABC Board Order No. 2026-229, attached as Exhibit
19 A.

20 Number 2, property owner acknowledges
21 that it is responsible for returning any property
22 owned by Flowerz, LLC that remains in the
23 premises and over which Flowerz, LLC has a legal
24 right to return.

25 Number 3, property owner agrees to

1 not lease the premises to any unlicensed cannabis
2 establishment at any time in the future.

3 Four, property owner agrees that if a
4 future tenant of the premises, which has not
5 filed an accepted and pending application with
6 the ABC Board, knowingly engages, or attempts to
7 engage, in the purchase, sale, exchange,
8 delivery, or another form of commercial
9 transaction involving cannabis, it shall be a
10 subsequent violation of D.C. Code Section 7-
11 1671.08(f) and grounds for the Board to issue
12 subsequent notice of summary closure and issue
13 property owner a fine of up to \$10,000 under D.C.
14 Code Section 7-1675.01(b). Property owner agrees
15 to waive the notice requirement set forth in D.C.
16 Code Section 7-1675.01(a) in the instant matter.

17 And Five, the current summary closure
18 shall remain in effect until ABCA makes the keys
19 to the premises available to property owner for
20 pickup at its office or at another mutually
21 agreed-upon time and location. And the
22 recommendation for this is approval.

23 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
24 board members vote to approve the recommendations
25 as put forth by the Chair for the legal agenda -

1 medical cannabis addendum.

2 Is there a second?

3 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I second the
4 motion.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
6 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
7 vote.

8 Mr. Grant?

9 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

11 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

13 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

15 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
17 Anderson. I agree. The matter passes 5-0.

18 We now move to our ABC licensing
19 agenda. On the first agenda, there are 16
20 applications. I'm going to review all 16
21 applications and I'll make recommendations.

22 Then, I'll make a motion and ask that
23 ABC board members vote to approve the
24 recommendation as put forth by the Chair.

25 So, Number 1, review application to

1 extend safekeeping of license. This is for
2 Ziegfield's Secret, License Number 078663.
3 Recommendation approved through September 30th,
4 2026.

5 Number 2, review application to
6 extend safekeeping of license. This is for
7 Dancing Crab, License Number 090297. Approval
8 through September 30th, 2026.

9 Number 3, review application to
10 extend safekeeping of license. Dancing Crab,
11 LLC, formerly Tenley Grill, License Number
12 117245. Approval through September 30th, 2026.

13 Number 4, review application to
14 extend safekeeping of license. This is M Street
15 Entertainment, LLC, formerly Rira, R-I-R-A,
16 License Number 119608. Recommendation approval
17 through September 30th, 2026.

18 Number 5, review application to
19 extend safekeeping of license. This is to be
20 determined. This is for Canal Square Associates
21 LP, License Number 118463. Recommendation
22 approval through September 30th, 2026.

23 Number 6, review application to
24 extend safekeeping of license. This is for Kiin
25 Laow, License Number 1293637. Recommendation

1 approval through September 30th, 2026.

2 Number 7, review application to
3 extend safekeeping of license. This is for SB
4 Wine and Spirits, License Number 126840.
5 Recommendation approval through September 30th,
6 2026.

7 Number 8, review request to extend
8 safekeeping of license. This is for Grand
9 Liquors, License Number 125406. Recommendation
10 approval through September 30th, 2026.

11 Number 9, review application to
12 extend safekeeping of license. This is for Meli
13 Mezze Club, License Number 117790.
14 Recommendation approval through September 30th,
15 2026.

16 Number 10, review application to
17 extend safekeeping of license. This is Momiji,
18 M-O-M-I-I-I, License Number 076962.
19 Recommendation approval through September 30th,
20 2026.

21 Number 11, review application to
22 extend safekeeping of license. This is for
23 Congress Market, License Number 122081.
24 Recommendation approval through September 30th,
25 2026.

1 Number 12, review application for
2 change of hours. This is for Dance Place,
3 License Number 125838. Recommendation on
4 placard.

5 Number 13, review application for
6 street re-endorsement with 88 seats. This is for
7 Tap99, License Number 116883. Recommendation on
8 placard.

9 Number 14, review request for
10 approval to provide a gift of a coffee machine
11 that doesn't exceed \$500 in value to Calvert
12 Woodley Fine Wine and Spirits, License Number
13 129692. The request has been made by Breakthruh
14 Beverage, License Number 124554. Recommendation
15 approval.

16 Number 15, review request to remove
17 the carrier and delivery endorsement for the game
18 of skill endorsement from the license. This is
19 for St. Arnold's on Jefferson, License Number
20 085989. Recommendation approval.

21 And Number 16, review application to
22 withdraw the application for expansion of a
23 sidewalk café. This is for Immigrant Food,
24 License Number 115958. Recommendation approval.

25 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC

1 board members vote to approve the recommendations
2 as put forth by the Chair for the alcohol legal
3 agenda.

4 Is there a second?

5 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second the
6 motion.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
8 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
9 Mr. Grant?

10 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

12 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

14 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree
15 with the recommendations.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

17 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
19 I agree. The matter passed 5-0.

20 All right. So let's now do the
21 alcohol cancellation agenda. The ABC Board will
22 be cancelling the following license for the
23 reasons outlined below:

24 Petite Cerise, P-E-T-I-T-E, C-E-R-I-
25 S-E, License Number 118037. The licensee

1 requests cancellation.

2 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
3 Board vote to cancel this license. Is there a
4 second?

5 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I second.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has
7 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
8 vote.

9 Mr. Grant?

10 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

12 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

14 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

18 I agree. The matter passed 5-0.

19 We now move to the Board's temporary

23 move to have the ABC board members vote to
24 approve the recommendations as put forth by the
25 Chair.

5 three security guards. Recommendation approval.

10 security guards. Recommendation approval.

11 Number 3, a request from Julie

14 200 attendees, four security guards.
15 Recommendation approval.

16 Number 4, a request from Amir M.
17 Radwan for a One Day License Class F, game night.
18 This is April 26th. The License Number is
19 135508. 100 attendees, two security guards.
20 Recommendation approval.

21 Number 5, a request from Lisa Lennon,
22 a One Day License Class G, live concert. This is
23 March 28th. The License Number is 135433. 150
24 attendees, nine security guards. Recommendation
25 approval.

1 Number 6, a request from Lillian
2 Iverson, One Day License Class G, live
3 entertainment. April 4th. License Number
4 135479. 5,000 attendees, 100 security guards.
5 Recommendation approval.

6 Number 7, a request from Geoffrey
7 Giraud, G-I-R-A-U-D, One Day License Class G,
8 D.C. Cocktail Festival. This is March 28th. The
9 License Number is 135488. 1600 attendees, 32
10 security guards. Recommendation approval.

11 Number 8, a request from John Issa,
12 One Day License Class G, March Madness-related
13 event. This is March 26th through March 29th.
14 The License Number is 135516. 111 attendees,
15 four security guards. Recommendation approval.

16 Number 9, a request from Cecily
17 Mendie, a One Day License Class G, Cherry Blossom
18 Festival with DJ and go-go music. March 29th.
19 The License Number is 135450. 500 attendees, six
20 security guards. Recommendation approval.

21 And Number 10 is a request from DC
22 Brau Brewing, One Day Substantial Change,
23 anniversary party. Nature of substantial change,
24 set up beer garden in parking lot adjacent to
25 establishment. This is April 18th. The License

1 Number is 085083. Substantial Change License
2 26SC00585. Recommendation approval.

3 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
4 board members vote to approve the recommendation
5 that's put forth by the Chair for the Board's
6 temporary license and one day substantial change
7 docket.

8 Is there a second?

9 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I second.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows
11 has seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
12 vote.

13 Mr. Grant?

14 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

25 one on Number 1, which is -- let me go back to

1 it.

2 MR. MEADOWS: Mr. Garrett.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Which is the
4 license for Howard Garrett on the 20th. All
5 right. Thank you.

6 Okay. So, the Board did vote. All
7 right, fine. All right. So, let's now move on
8 to the licensing administrative docket. On the
9 licensing administrative docket, there are 32
10 applications on this docket.

11 And so, without objection, I make a
12 motion that ABC board members vote to approve all
13 the applications -- all 32 applications on the
14 licensing administrative docket for March 18th,
15 2026.

16 Is there a second?

17 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I second the

21 Mr. Grant?

22 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

12 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones --

14 MR. JONES: I'm sorry. Mr. Jones. I
15 second the motion.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Mr.
17 Jones has seconded the motion. We'll now have a
18 roll call vote.

19 Mr. Grant?

20 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

22 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

11 So, Number 1, you have an application
12 from Hollistic District. It's a medical cannabis
13 retailer with delivery endorsement. This is a new
14 standard application. The recommendation is a
15 fact-finding.

16 Number 2, a request from C'Est Modi,
17 C-E-S-T, M-O-D-I. The License Number is 127934.
18 It's a medical cannabis retailer with delivery
19 endorsement. The trade name is now -- change in
20 the trade name from C'Est Modi to The Dispensary.
21 Recommendation approval.

22 Number 3, this is District Wellness
23 Center, License Number 127954, medical cannabis
24 retailer with delivery endorsement, new
25 application, social equity application.

1 Recommendation fact-finding.

2 Number 4, Green Cloud Shop, License
3 Number 130775, medical cannabis retailer with
4 delivery endorsement, new application, standard
5 applicant. Recommendation approval.

6 I, therefore, make a motion that ABC
7 board vote to approve the recommendations as put
8 forth by the Chair for the medical cannabis
9 license administrative docket.

10 is there a second?

11 MR. JONES: Mr. Jones --

12 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn --

13 MR. JONES: -- I second the motion.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones and
15 Ms. Quinn have seconded the motion. We'll have a
16 roll call vote.

17 Mr. Grant?

18 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

20 MS. QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?
