3 MS. FLETCHER: There is one case on  
4 the calendar today. This is the case of Dog  
5 Daze, Case No. 23-PRO-00029, Dog Daze DC, LLC,  
6 1100 Rhode Island Avenue Northwest, License No.  
7 ABRA-123636. This is a Retailer Class CT, new  
8 application. The protest issues are adverse  
9 impact on peace, order, and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
12 Agent.

13 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 2F?

14 Mr. Miller, you're on mute.

15 MR. MILLER: Can you hear me now?

16 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

17 MR. MILLER: I'm so sorry about that.

18 Yes. My name is Brant Miller. I am the  
19 Commissioner for SMD 2F07, representing ANC 2F.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Miller, what's your  
21 first name again?

22 MR. MILLER: Brant, B-R-A-N-T.

23 MS. FLETCHER: B-R-A-N-T, Brant.

24 Thank you, Brant Miller. Okay. Mr. Miller,  
25 thank you.

1                   The Applicant has not yet appeared.  
2                   We wait for ten minutes in case anybody's having  
3                   any technical difficulties. We've got about  
4                   seven minutes. We'll see.

5                   MR. MILLER: Great. Thank you.

6                   MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Miller, I do have  
7                   a question for you. Are you going to be the  
8                   designated representative throughout these  
9                   proceedings?

10                  MR. MILLER: That is correct.

11                  MS. FLETCHER: May I have your email  
12                  address?

13                  MR. MILLER: Yes. I put the wrong  
14                  email address when I signed into WebEx. My email  
15                  address is 2f07@anc.dc.gov.

16                  MS. FLETCHER: That's 2f07@anc.dc.gov?

17                  MR. MILLER: That's correct.

18                  MS. FLETCHER: And Mr. Miller, do you  
19                  have a telephone number that you would like to  
20                  say publicly? You can email it to me later.

21                  MR. MILLER: I can say it publicly.  
22                  I just have to get my phone and look at what my  
23                  phone number is, which is very silly but  
24                  something I have to do. I have an ANC number and  
25                  a not-ANC number. The ANC number is the one I

1 usually have to look up. It is area code 202-  
2 618-0814.

3 MS. FLETCHER: 202-618-0184?

4 MR. MILLER: That is correct.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.  
6 I will update the record. What that means, Mr.  
7 Miller, is that you will receive all the WebEx  
8 invitations from this point forward. Mr. Floria,  
9 F-L-O-R-I-A, received this one because he filed  
10 the protest.

11 MR. MILLER: Thank you.

12 MS. FLETCHER: We'll make you the  
13 designated representative.

14 MR. MILLER: Thank you very much.  
15 Yes, we have to share the designated  
16 representative glove across the Commission.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, you do.

18 (Pause.)

19 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Mr. Kim.

20 MR. KIM: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher.  
21 I apologize. I was given the wrong link.

22 MS. FLETCHER: No problem. You're  
23 here on behalf of the Applicant?

24 MR. KIM: That's correct, Dog Daze.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Kim, for some

1 reason you're a little choppy. I'm going to  
2 spell your name for the record. It's spelled J-  
3 I-S-O-O. Your last name is Kim, K-I-M.

4 MR. KIM: That's correct.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. Mr. Kim is  
6 present on behalf of the Applicant.

7 Mr. Kim, thank you for coming. ANC 2F  
8 is the protestant in this matter. Mr. Brant  
9 Miller is present on behalf of ANC 2F. ANC 2F  
10 does have standing as a protestant.

11 We need to schedule a date for a  
12 status hearing, a protest hearing, and a  
13 mediation. I'm going to give you the date for  
14 the status and protest hearing first.

15 The status hearing is set for April  
16 12, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. That's the status  
17 hearing. The protest hearing is set for May 17,  
18 2023 at 1:30.

19 And I will give you the next available  
20 date for mediation. The next available date for  
21 mediation is actually on a Wednesday, but that  
22 may not be the best day because that's also a  
23 Board hearing day.

24 What about Friday, March 31? Is that  
25 good for anyone?

1 MR. MILLER: That date specifically  
2 would probably be a challenge for me.

3 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to move to  
4 the next week.

5 MR. MILLER: Okay.

6 MS. FLETCHER: I'll see what's  
7 available. What about Thursday, April 6th?

8 MR. MILLER: That's fine with me.

9 MS. FLETCHER: What about you, Mr.  
10 Kim?

11 MR. KIM: Works for the Applicant.  
12 Thank you.

13 MS. FLETCHER: So that would be  
14 anytime between 10:00 and 1:30.

15 MR. KIM: The Applicant's available.

16 MR. MILLER: One second. Are you  
17 asking for a specific time between 10:00 and 1:30  
18 --

19 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

20 MR. MILLER: -- on the 6th? Let me  
21 double check one thing. The 6th, any of those  
22 times, but I would probably say 10:00 would be  
23 great.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Is 10:00 okay for you  
25 too, Mr. Kim?

1 MR. KIM: That is fine. Thank you.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for  
3 Thursday, April 6th at 10:00.

4 Does anybody have any questions at  
5 all?

6 I would like to do one thing before  
7 you leave. I want to add something to the  
8 internal recording of this proceeding.

9 This is the matter of Dog Daze, Case  
10 No. 23-PRO-00029, 1100 Rhode Island Avenue  
11 Northwest, License No. ABRA-123636. This is a  
12 Retailer Class CT, new license application.

13 ANC 2F is the protestant. Brant  
14 Miller is present today on behalf of ANC 2F. Mr.  
15 Kim is present on behalf of the Applicant. The  
16 protest issues are adverse impact on peace,  
17 order, and quiet. I am conducting the roll call  
18 hearing as the Board's Agent.

19 That's all I wanted to add for our  
20 recording. Thank you very much for coming. I  
21 will see you on April 6th. And I'll send out the  
22 WebEx invitation for you to attend the mediation  
23 as well.

24 MR. KIM: Okay. Thank you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you for

1 coming.

2 MR. MILLER: Thank you. Have a good  
3 day.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Roll call hearing  
5 concluded. Thank you. You too.

6 MR. KIM: Have a nice day.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Bye-bye.
