1 for a Protest Hearing, there are a few things I 2 would like to instruct you about because the Board's practices have changed. 3 Following this hearing because as I 4 5 stated because all the hearings are now virtual, following this hearing you will receive an email 6 7 from the legal office that will include a copy of 8 a Protest Information Form (PIF) and a copy of an 9 Exhibit form, as well as specific instructions for the hearing. 10 11 You are required to -- hello? 12 right. 13 If we do not receive a copy of your 14 form seven days before the hearing, your 15 application -- can everyone hear me? 16 MR. KLINE: Yes. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I think I want 17 18 everyone to be on camera because I just -- I 19 don't see all my Board Members. 20 MS. LaRUE: Your audio has been going 21 in and out. Then at one point we lost your 2.2 visual as well. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 2.4 I don't know, and that's one of the reasons now I 25 can only see -- I see Mr. Kline, I see Mr.

These documents not only need to be

1 sent -- these documents for Protest issues 2 facilitating the process and keeping the parties (audio interference) on point during the hearing. 3 The Board does not intend to hear 4 5 testimony in matters that are not relevant to both (audio interference). 6 7 Can you folks hear me? Thank you. 8 Let me -- I apologize for that (audio 9 interference) together and I'm having some 10 technological problems this morning. But can 11 everyone hear me? 12 MS. LaRUE: I can now. I can now but I couldn't before. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 14 15 did you hear, in effect, that seven days before 16 the hearing you're supposed to provide us with a 17 copy of your PIF. 18 MS. LaRUE: Got it. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Let 20 me go back -- let me go back to -- let me go back to my laptop. I'm switching devices again, I 21 2.2 apologize. 23 All right.
