3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I will now do  
4 our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal  
5 agenda is the review of an Offer-in-Compromise in  
6 lieu of a hearing, dated March 22, 2022. The  
7 case number is 22-CMP-00005, DC Food Market,  
8 license number 106962.

9 And the Offer-in-Compromise is that  
10 Charge 1, extended hours of operation without  
11 approval, statutory authority D.C. Code  
12 Section 25-762. There will be a fine of \$2,000,  
13 payable within 120 days of the Board accepting  
14 the Offer-in-Compromise, and if payment is not  
15 made within 120 days, the license will be  
16 suspended until payment has been made.

17 For Charge 2, no owner or ABC manager  
18 present on premises during hours of field service  
19 and consumption of alcohol, statutory authority  
20 23 DCMR Section 707.1.

21 There's a fine of \$2,000, payable  
22 within 120 days of the Board accepting the OIC.  
23 If payment is not made within 120 days, the  
24 license will be suspended until payment is made.

25 And Charge 3, failure to follow the

1 terms of the license by extending hours of  
2 operations, statutory authority D.C. Code,  
3 Section 25-82387. This charge has been  
4 dismissed.

5 I, therefore, make a motion that the  
6 ABC Board accepts this Offer-in-Compromise. Is  
7 there a second?

8 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

4 number 21-CMP-00054, case number 21-CMP-00070,  
5 case number 21-CMP-00072, case  
6 number 22-CMP-00001, and case  
7 number 22-CMP-00003. This is the Mirror Lounge  
8 license number 111950.

9           And the Offer-in-Compromise is as  
10 follows: The case number 21-CMP-00054, Charge 1,  
11 allow music to emanate from the establishment at  
12 such intensity that it may be heard inside of the  
13 nearby residences, statutory authority D.C. Code,  
14 Section 25-725(a).

15           There's a fine of \$500, payable within  
16 120 days, or the license shall be suspended  
17 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

18           For case number 21-CMP-00070,  
19 Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the  
20 establishment with such intensity that it may be  
21 heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory  
22 authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a).

23           The fine is a \$500 fine, payable  
24 within 120 days, or the license shall be  
25 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been

1 paid.

2 For case number 21-CMP-00072,  
3 Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the  
4 establishment at such intensity that it may be  
5 heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory  
6 authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a). A  
7 warning will be issued for this case.

8 The case number 22-CMP-00001,  
9 Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the  
10 establishment at such intensity that it may be  
11 heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory  
12 authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a). This  
13 charge has been dismissed.

14 And for case number 22-CMP-00003,  
15 Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the  
16 establishment at such intensity that it may be  
17 heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory  
18 authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a). This  
19 case is also dismissed.

20 I, therefore, make a motion that the  
21 Offer-in-Compromise be accepted. Is there a

22 is a wedding on April 13, 2022. The license  
23 number is 120866, 60 attendees to it, a security  
24 guard.

1 Amelia Neptune, for a one-day license, Class F.  
2 This is for a reception for the League of  
3 American Bicyclists. This is on March 30, 2022.  
4 The license number is 120862. This is  
5 110 attendees, two security guards.

6 Number four is a request from Adriana  
7 Babic, a one-day license, Class G. This is a  
8 fundraiser for Thomas Circle Singers. This is on  
9 April 30, 2022. The license number is 120826,  
10 100 attendees, three security guards/volunteers.

11 Number five is a request from Steve  
12 Bilidas, a one-day license, Class G. This is for  
13 a reception for Axios Media. This is April 4th  
14 through April 5th. The license number is 120828,  
15 and up to 300 attendees and six security guards.

16 Number six, a request from Jonathan  
17 Reef, a one-day license, Class G. This is a  
18 fundraiser for the Merch PTA. This is on  
19 April 23, 2022. The license number is 120827,  
20 300 attendees and security guards.

21 Number seven is a request from  
22 Matthias Galica for a one-day license, Class G.  
23 This is a wedding on May 6, 2022. The license  
24 number is 120851, 125 attendees, three security  
25 guards.

1           Number eight is a request from Miles  
2 Peters, a one-day license, Class G. This is a  
3 wedding on April 2, 2022 and the license number  
4 is 120863, 125 attendees, three security guards.

5           Number nine, a request from Maria  
6 Murphy, a one-day license, Class G. This is a  
7 reception at the Whitfield Entertainment Group  
8 Studios, Inc. This is for March 28 and March 29,  
9 2022. The license number is 120880,  
10 19 attendees, 38 security guards.

11           Number ten, a request from Studio 52  
12 Mrs. X LLC, a one-day substantial change.  
13 They're requesting a one-day substantial change  
14 to extend out from 2:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. This  
15 is on April 2, 2022. The license number is  
16 115069. The substantial change license number is  
17 22-SC-00578.

18           Number 11 is a request from the Army &  
19 Navy Club, a one-day substantial change. It's a  
20 one-day substantial change to use license off-  
21 premises on the 12th floor of the same building.  
22 This is on May 18, 2022. The license number is  
23 000114. Substantial change license number is  
24 22-SC-00579.

25           Number 12, another request from the

1 Army & Navy Club, one-day substantial change.  
2 They're requesting a one-day substantial change  
3 to use the license off-premises, on the  
4 12th floor of the same building. This is on  
5 June 15, 2022. The license number is 000114.  
6 The substantial change license number is  
7 22-SC-00580.

8 Number 13, another request from the  
9 Army & Navy Club, a one-day substantial change.

19 building. This is on August 17, 2022. The  
20 license number is 000114. The substantial change  
21 license number is 22-SC-00582.

22 Number 15, another request from the  
23 Army & Navy Club for a one-day substantial  
24 change, the one-day substantial change to use the  
25 license off-premises. It's on the 12th floor of

1 the same building. This is on September 21,  
2 2022. The license number is 000114. Substantial  
3 change license number is 22-SC-00583.

4 I, therefore, make a motion that the  
5 ABC Board grant the requests in the 15  
6 establishments that were -- license application  
7 that were just read in the record. Is there a  
8 second?

9 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett  
10 seconds.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett  
12 has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll  
13 call vote. Mr. Short.

14 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato.

16 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett.

18 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I  
19 agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen.

21 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And  
23 Mr. Grandis.

24 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis. I  
25 agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And  
2 Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 6-0-0.

3 We have three more requests on our  
4 one-day substantial change license. And these  
5 are three bar crawls made by the Good Bar Crawl.

6 I'm going to make a motion that the  
7 ABC Board grant the pub crawl with an approval of  
8 950 participants. So, we left where the motion  
9 is, I'll read the three bar crawls, the  
10 recommendation, and then we'll vote on the three  
11 bar crawls.

12 The first bar crawl, the Good Bar  
13 Crawl, is a pub crawl. They're requesting

20 number 000892. They're a Retailer C ex-club,  
21 change of officer application to add William G.  
22 Simpson as secretary.

23 I, therefore, make a motion that the
