CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I will now do our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal agenda is the review of an Offer-in-Compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated March 22, 2022. The case number is 22-CMP-00005, DC Food Market, license number 106962.

And the Offer-in-Compromise is that Charge 1, extended hours of operation without approval, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-762. There will be a fine of $\$ 2,000$, payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the Offer-in-Compromise, and if payment is not made within 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment has been made.

For Charge 2, no owner or ABC manager present on premises during hours of field service and consumption of alcohol, statutory authority 23 DCMR Section 707.1.

There's a fine of \$2,000, payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the OIC. If payment is not made within 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment is made.

And Charge 3, failure to follow the
terms of the license by extending hours of operations, statutory authority D.C. Code, Section 25-82387. This charge has been dismissed.

I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board accepts this Offer-in-Compromise. Is there a second?

For case number 21-CMP-00070, Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the establishment with such intensity that it may be heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a).

The fine is a $\$ 500$ fine, payable within 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
paid.
For case number 21-CMP-00072, Charge 1, allow music to emanate from the establishment at such intensity that it may be heard inside of the nearby residences, statutory authority D.C. Code, Section 25-725(a). A warning will be issued for this case.

The first bar crawl, the Good Bar Crawl, is a pub crawl. They're requesting 950 attendees. This is the brunch crawl. This is on July 30, 2022. The license number is 112754. The substantial change number is 22-SC-00574. Their asking for bar crawl on the U Street corridor beginning at 9th and U Street, up to $U$ Street at 14 th and $U$.

I make a motion that the ABC Board approve the pub crawls for 950 participants. Is there a second?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote of the motion. Mr. Short.

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. Because of public safety and the numbers of people on U Street, I don't think will be supported by the city. I vote to deny 16 , the $950, ~ I$ vote to deny number 17 for 950, and I vote for number 18, to deny because of 950 people on $U$ Street. I vote to deny. Thank you, Mr. Chair.

MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett. MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen. MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis. MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis agrees with the motion.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passes five to one. Thank you.

We now move to License Administrative Docket. On our license administrative docket there are 13 applicants. I'll read the name of the 13 applicants, the class category, and what's being requested. At the end of the list, 1 will ask that the ABC Board approve these applications.
