3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're on the  
4 record. Good afternoon everyone, and welcome to  
5 the afternoon session of the ABC Board. My name  
6 is Donovan Anderson. I'm Chairman of the ABC  
7 Board.

8 We have five other members with us  
9 this afternoon. The five members are Mr. James  
10 Short, Ms. Rafi Crockett, Mr. Bobby Cato,  
11 Ms. Jeni Hansen, and Mr. Edward Grandis.

12 The Board has six members for the  
13 conduct of business, and that constitutes a  
14 quorum.

15 Before we get underway with this  
16 afternoon's calendar, I need to make a few  
17 instructions very clear so that the conduct of  
18 these hearings is understood by everyone.

19 There are four cases scheduled for  
20 this afternoon. Once the case is called, I will  
21 take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate  
22 the rights for each party, to enable their camera  
23 and microphone. Then, and only then, will you  
24 have the ability to enable your equipment. If  
25 your case has not been heard, you will remain

1 mute and your camera will be disabled.

2 At the conclusion of each case, the  
3 parties will have the option to leave. If a  
4 party chooses to stay, all cameras and  
5 microphones for the concluded case will be  
6 disabled.
