3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so now let
4 us now go to our agendas for the day. The first
5 agenda item that the Board will address today,
6 it's a settlement -- it's, I'm sorry, legal
7 agenda, alcohol. The first matter on the legal
8 agenda, alcohol, it's a review of a settlement
9 agreement.

10 This is in Case No. 26-PRO-00009. This
11 is MK Lounge and Restaurant, License No. 088787.

12 That matter, it's a recommendation to the Board
13 for the Board to approve the settlement
14 agreement.

15 Number 2, it's a review of a settlement
16 agreement. This is for Open Crumb, License No.
17 134513. Recommendation is to approve the
18 settlement agreement.

19 And number 3, review of emergency
20 rulemaking to maintain the Glover Park
21 Moratorium Zone. And the Board will -- the
22 recommendation is that the Board should approve
23 this matter. I therefore make a motion that ABC
24 Board vote to approve the recommendation that's
25 put forth by the Board -- by the chair for the

1 legal agenda, alcohol. Is there a second?

2 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I second.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn second
4 the motion. We'll have a roll call vote. Mr.
5 Grant?

6 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

8 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

10 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

12 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

14 Anderson. I agree. The matter passes 5-0. We
15 now move to our legal agenda, alcohol addendum.

16 There are two matters on this agenda. I will
17 review the record, then I'll make a
18 recommendation and then I'll make a motion that
19 the Board approve the recommendation as put
20 forth by the chair.

21 So number 1, review of a settlement
22 agreement -- excuse me. This is in Case No. 26-
23 PRO-00023, Tango Pastry Kitchen and Bar, License
24 No. 134324. Recommendation, approve the
25 settlement agreement.

1 Number 2, offer in compromise. This is
2 in Case No. 25-251-00012, Twelve After Twelve,
3 License No. 117238. The offer in compromise is
4 as follows.

5 Charge 1, allow the establishment to be
6 used for an unlawful or disorderly purpose,
7 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
8 823(a)(2). There's a 4,000-dollar fine payable
9 within 30 days or the license shall be suspended
10 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

11 Charge No. 2, failed to follow security plans,
12 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
13 823(a)(6). There is a 4,000-dollar fine payable
14 within 30 days or the license shall be suspended
15 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

16 Charge No. 3, failed to follow security
17 plan, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
18 823(a)(6). This charge has been dismissed.

19 Charge 4, failed to follow security plan,
20 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
21 823(a)(6). This charge has also been dismissed.

22 Charge 5, failed to follow statutory --
23 failed to follow security plan, statutory
24 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(6).

25 Charge 5 has also been dismissed. Charge 6,

1 failed to ensure cameras were operational,
2 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
3 836(g)(1). This charge has been dismissed.

4 Charge 7, allow a patron to exit the
5 establishment with an alcoholic beverage,
6 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
7 113(a)(2)(A)(ii). There is a fine of 250
8 dollars payable within 30 days or the license
9 shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine
10 has been paid. Charge 8, failed to carry ABC
11 manager's license, statutory authority, D.C.
12 Code Section 25-711(e). There is a mandatory
13 warning issued for Charge 8.

14 And for Charge 9, ABC manager made
15 false or misleading statements, statutory
16 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(1).
17 There is a 4,000-dollar fine payable within 30
18 days or the license shall be suspended
19 indefinitely until the fine has been paid. The
20 recommendation, approval. So I therefore make a
21 motion that a ABC Board members vote to approve
22 the recommendation as put forth by the chair for
23 the legal agenda, alcohol addendum. Is there a
24 second?

25 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I

1 second.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
3 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
4 Mr. Grant?

5 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

7 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

9 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

11 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
13 Anderson. I agree. The matter passes 5-0.

14 Let's now move to our licensing agenda. The
15 first agenda we will do is the alcohol licensing
16 agenda. On this agenda, there are eight
17 applications. I'll review all eight. I will
18 make recommendations, and then I'll make a
19 motion that ABC Board members vote to approve
20 the recommendation as put forth by the chair.

21 So No. 1 is the request to remove the
22 license from safekeeping for reopening under
23 transfer entity. This is District Larder,
24 formerly Farm to Feast, License No. -- the old
25 license number is 126864. The new license

1 number is 135497. Recommendation, approval.

2 No. 2, review application to extend
3 safekeeping of license. This is Iraklion,
4 License No. 116082. Recommendation, approval
5 through September 30th, 2026.

6 No. 3, review application to extend
7 safekeeping of license. This is for Cookie
8 Corner, License No. 111680. Recommendation,
9 approval through September 30th, 2026.

10 No. 4, review application to extend
11 safekeeping of license. This is Wine and Spirit
12 Depot, License No. 126931. Recommendation,
13 approval through September 30th, 2026.

14 No. 5, review application to extend
15 safekeeping of license. This is for Artechouse,
16 License No. 103519. Recommendation, approval
17 through September 30th, 2026.

18 No. 6, review application to extend
19 safekeeping of license. This is for Sprig &
20 Sprout, License No. 089362. Recommendation,
21 approval through September 30th, 2026.

22 No. 7, review application to extend
23 safekeeping of license. This is Ben's Chili
24 Bowl/Ben's Next Door/Ben's Upstairs, License No.
25 131844. Recommendation, approval through

1 September 30th, 2026.

2 And No. 8, review request to allow 1201
3 K Street F&B Tenant LLC to serve as corporate
4 paymaster for alcoholic beverage purchases from
5 wholesalers and manufacturers. This request is
6 from the Eaton DC/Allegory/Wild Days, License
7 No. 123549. Recommendation, approval.

8 I therefore make a motion that ABC
9 Board members vote to approve the recommendation
10 as put forth by the chair of the alcohol
11 licensing agenda. Is there a second?

12 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second the
13 motion.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
15 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
16 Mr. Grant?

17 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

19 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

21 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

23 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

3 No. 1, review request for a temporary
4 operating retail permit. This is for The Dock
5 Shop, License No. 135569. Recommendation,
6 approval. I therefore make a motion that ABC
7 Board votes to approve this TORP. Is there a
8 second?

9 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second the
10 motion.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
12 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
13 Mr. Grant?

14 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

16 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

18 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

20 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

22 Anderson. I agree. The matter passed 5-0. We
23 now move to the alcohol cancellation agenda.
24 The ABC Board will be canceling the following
25 licenses for the reasons outlined before.

1 No. 1, Chicken and Whiskey, License No.
2 118586. The licensee requested cancellation.
3 No. 2, Paste & Rind Cheese Company, License No.
4 122723. Licensee requested cancellation. I
5 make a motion that ABC Board vote to cancel
6 those two licenses. Is there a second?

7 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I second.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has
9 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
10 Mr. Grant?

11 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

13 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

19 Recommendation, approval.

20 No. 19, Lucky Pollo/District Eagle, one
21 day substantial change, after-hours party.
22 Nature of substantial change, to host an after-
23 hours party. This is March 29th. The license
24 number is 117897. Substantial change license is
25 26-SC-00589. Recommendation, approval.

1 No. 20, The Harp/Irish Goodbye, LLC,
2 one day substantial change, traditional Irish
3 celebration. This is March 29th. The license
4 number is 133946. Substantial change license is
5 26-SC-00591. Recommendation, approval.

6 No. 21, Whitlow's, one day substantial

3 The license number is 133946. Substantial
4 change license, 26-SC-00590. Recommendation,

6 I therefore make a motion that ABC
7 Board members vote to approve the recommendation
8 put forth by the chair for the Board's temporary

10 a second?

15 safe-use treatment facility. This is The
16 Warehouse, License No. 129377. Recommendation,
17 a fact finding.

18 No. 3, review of change of hours
19 request for Higher Ground. The license number
20 is 129388. Recommendation, approval.

21 And No. 4, review application to extend
22 safekeeping of license. This is for Granny
23 Za's, License No. 126762. Recommendation,
24 approval through September 30th, 2026.

25 I therefore make a motion that ABC

1 Board members vote to approve the recommendation
2 as put forth by the chair for the medical
3 cannabis licensing agenda. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second the
5 motion.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
7 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
8 Mr. Grant?

9 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

11 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

2 concerning ongoing or planned investigations of
3 alleged criminal or civil misconduct or
4 violations of law or regulations and seek legal
5 advice from our legal counsel on the Board's

7 agenda for April 1st as published in the D.C.
8 Register on March 27th. Is there a second?

9 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I second.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn has
11 second the motion. I'll take a roll call vote
12 on the motion before us now that has been
13 properly second. Mr. Grant?

14 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Quinn?

16 MEMBER QUINN: Ms. Quinn. I agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

18 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

20 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

22 Anderson. I agree. As the motion has passed, I
23 hereby give notice that ABC Board will hold this
24 closed meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings
25 Act. Notice will also be posted on ABC Board

1 and our own bulletin board, calendar and ABCA's
2 website, and published in D.C. Register in a
3 timely manner as practical. We're now adjourned
4 for the day.

5 We'd like to thank the Board members
6 for their time and attention and the public who
7 are participating in our hearing today. I now
8 ask all Board members to return to executive
9 session for further development. Good
10 afternoon, and thank you.
