3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on
4 our calendar is Case No. 23-CMP-00071, Ristorante
5 Piccolo.

6 Mr. Jameson, can you elevate the
7 Licensee in this case?

8 MR. JAMESON: I do not see the Licensee
9 in here.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
11 That's fine.

12 Mr. Cenci, can you identify yourself
13 for the record, please

14 MR. CENCI: Collin Cenci, C-O-L-L-I-N
15 C-E-N-C-I.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, hold
17 on a minute. Hold on a minute.

18 It appears that Mr. Mixon is there.

12 MR. MIXON: Cameron Mixon with The
13 Veritas Law Firm, the Counsel for the Licensee,
14 C-A-M-E-R-O-N Mixon, M-I-X-O-N.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16 sir.

17 All right. Are there any preliminary
18 matters in this case?

19 MR. CENCI: None from the Government.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. This
21 matter then is scheduled for a show cause hearing
22 on March 8th at 1:30 p.m. I just want to remind
23 both parties that seven days before the hearing
24 the parties are required to exchange documents
25 and witnesses. Failure by either side to

1 exchange documents or witnesses seven days before
2 the hearing, unless good cause is shown, the
3 Board is empowered to prevent that side from
4 relying in documents and witnesses that have not
5 been disclosed.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
