MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is District Still. This is Case No. 22-PRO-00018, District Still LLC, 4400 Jenifer Street, NW, license number ABRA-102521.

This is a Retailer Class A license transfer, to transfer from 175 R Street, $N E$, to 4400 Jenifer Street, NW. That's Jenifer spelled J-E-N-I-F-E-R.

The protest issues are adverse impact, peace order and quiet, and residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing at the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of the applicant?

MR. BIANCO: Good morning,
Ms. Fletcher, Richard Bianco. I represent the applicant in this case.

MS. FLETCHER: Good morning,
Mr. Bianco.
MR. BIANCO: How are you?
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, I'm doing good,
thank you. Would you spell your name for the record, please?

MR. BIANCO: Sure. First name is Richard, R-I-C-H-A-R-D. Last name is Bianco, B-I-A-N-C-O.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. I'll note for the record that ANC3E is the protestant in this matter. Although ANC3E is not present today, they're going to be granted standing today because Jonathan Bender -- I'll spell that for the court reporter. That's spelled J-O-N-A-T-H-A-N, Bender, B-E-N-D-E-R.

Mr. Bender is the Chair of ANC3E and he would have been present today, but he informed ABRA on March 24 of a family emergency that required him to leave immediately.

And so, in that case, we will not dismiss ANC3E as a protestant. And based on communication that I received from Mr. Bianco, Mr. Bianco, you're not opposed to that?

MR. BIANCO: That's correct. The applicant consents.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you,
Mr. Bianco. ANC3E is granted standing.
Mr. Bianco, I'll go ahead and give the dates, and
then I'll provide them to Mr. Bender later.
MR. BIANCO: Great.
MS. FLETCHER: Let's see here. I'll give you the date for the status hearing first. The status hearing is set for May 4, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for June 8, 2022 at 1:30.

Mr. Bianco, I'm going to go ahead and run some dates by you. And if there's any one that works for you, I'm going to run that by Mr. Bender. If it doesn't work for him, then I'll send out some more dates.

MR. BIANCO: That's perfectly fine.
MS. FLETCHER: The next available day for mediation is actually Tuesday, April 12. Tuesday April, any time between 9:00 a.m. and 1:30.

MR. BIANCO: I am available. Could we say 11:30, tentatively? And then, if Mr. Bender needs to change, $I$ can be flexible.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Right ahead, mediation bound for 11:30 on Tuesday, April 12. And I'll check with Mr. Bender. I'll email him and copy you, Mr. Bianco.

MR. BIANCO: Great.

MS. FLETCHER: And thank you for coming.

MR. BIANCO: Thank you very much, Ms. Fletcher. A pleasure, as always.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, as always. Thank you very much. See you soon. The roll call hearing in the matter of District Still is concluded.
