3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, let us now  
4 do our legal agenda. The first matter on our  
5 legal agenda is a review of offer in compromise  
6 in lieu of hearing dated March 28, 2023 for case  
7 number 2022, I'm sorry, 22-CMP-00083, Aslin Beer  
8 Company, license number 118555.

9 And the offer in compromise is as  
10 follows, charge one, provide entertainment  
11 without the endorsement, statutory authority D.C.  
12 Code Section 25-113.01(b)(1), and the fine, in  
13 this case, a warning, will be issued.

14 I make a motion that the offer in  
15 compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

16 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, second.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis has  
18 seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call  
19 vote. Mr. Short?

20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

4 Number two, review of an offer in  
5 compromise in lieu of a hearing dated March 28,  
6 2023 for case number 22-CC-00024, Liff's Market,  
7 license number 0888858.

8 And the offer in compromise is as  
9 follows, charge one, sale to minors, statutory  
10 authority D.C. Code Section 25-781, fine \$2,000  
11 payable within 30 days or the license shall be  
12 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been  
13 paid.

14 Then there is a suspension. The  
15 license shall be suspended for five days, with  
16 all five days stayed for one year, and then term  
17 three of charge one, all employees who serve  
18 alcoholic beverages in the licensed  
19 establishment, they must complete alcohol  
20 training within three months from the OIC date.

21 Charge two, failed to ascertain legal  
22 age, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-  
23 783(b). There is a fine of \$1,000 payable within  
24 30 days or the license shall be suspended  
25 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

1 Charge three, no owner or ABC on duty  
2 during the establishment's hours of operation and  
3 sale, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-  
4 701 and 23 DCMR Section 707.1. There is a \$250  
5 fine payable within 30 days or the license shall  
6 be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been  
7 paid.

8 I make a motion that the offer in  
9 compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

6 ABC license application.

7                   Number 11, Queen's Bar and Lounge,

10                  Number 12, Urban Grape, license number

12 application.

13                  Number 13, Amelie, license number

15 application. I'm asking that number 13 be  
16 referred back to licensing.

17                  Number 14, Big Valu Liquor, license  
18 number 124074, Retailer A liquor store, new ABC  
19 license application.

20                  Number 15, Eat Brgz, license number  
21 123652, Retailer C restaurant, transfer with sale  
22 application.

23                  And so, therefore, I make a motion  
24 that the ABC Board grant these requests on these  
25 applicants. Is there a second?

1 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
3 seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call  
4 vote. Mr. Short?

5 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

7 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?  
9 (No audible response.)

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

20 I will name all four licensees, and  
21 then at the end of the list, I'll ask if the ABC  
22 Board should approve the applications, excuse me.

23 The first request is a request from  
24 Haikan, H-A-I-K-A-N, license number 100622,  
25 Retailer C restaurant. They're again requesting

1 for the Streatery endorsement application.

6 and if there are no further questions, I'm going  
7 to close the record for the day.

8 As Chairperson of the Alcoholic  
9 Beverage Control Board for the District of  
10 Columbia, in accordance with D.C. Official Code  
11 Section 2-575(b) and Section 2-575(b)(14) of the  
12 Open Meetings Act, I move that the ABC hold a  
13 closed meeting on April 5, 2023 for the purpose  
14 of discussing and hearing reports concerning  
15 ongoing or planned investigation of alleged  
16 criminal or civil misconduct, or violations of  
17 law or regulations, and seeking legal advice from  
18 our legal counsel on the matters identified on

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

6 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,

10 I agree. As it appears that the motion has
