Mr. 5 Bianco, this is the summary suspension hearing for Case Number 22-251-00007, Cloud Restaurant 6 7 and Lounge Sports Bar. Let's have the parties 8 introduce themselves for the record starting with 9 the Government, please. 10 MR. CELO: Assistant Attorney General 11 Anthony Celo for the Government, A-N-T-H-O-N-Y, 12 C-E-L-O. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon, 14 Mr. Celo. 15 MR. CELO: Good afternoon. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bianco. 17 MR. BIANCO: Good afternoon again, Mr. 18 Anderson. Richard Bianco for the respondent. 19 Last name spelled B-I-A-N-C-O. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon, 21 sir. All right. This is a summary suspension 22 hearing. We had a hearing scheduled for last 23 The parties told us that they were working week. 24 on some type of offer in compromise, so we have 25 the hearing today. So where are we this

afternoon, Mr. Celo?

MR. CELO: We have reached an offer in compromise that has been agreed upon by the parties.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what are the terms of the offer in compromise, please?

MR. CELO: The offer in compromise is about five pages. I can read it into the record if you like, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. You have to read it in the record and then I have to read it into the record also so yes, please read the offer in compromise in the record.

MR. CELO: Very well. In the matter of Kat, LLC, t/a Cloud Restaurant & Lounge Sports Bar, the District of Columbia, jointly with the licensee respondent, submits this offer in compromise, "OIC," to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, "the Board," as authorized by 23 DCRM 1604.5 for approval by the Board. The parties understand that if the Board approves the OIC, this case will conclude. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC shown below. If the Board does not approve the OIC, litigation of the summary suspension will

continue. By accepting this OIC, respondent does not admit to liability.

Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation to accept an OIC. Respondent has been advised to service on the notice of summary suspension that any summary suspension hearing or other proceedings, respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, crossexamine witnesses, and apply to the Board for a qualified interpreter.

The OIC terms are as follows. One, revise security plan. Respondent shall submit an updated security plan to ABRA and the Office of Attorney General, "OAG," by 5:00 p.m. on April 4, 2022. The security plan shall comply with all applicable requirements under DC Code Title 25 and corresponding regulations including 25 DCRM 402. The revised security plan shall be reviewed and accepted by the Board prior to lifting the suspension of the establishment's ABC license. The revised security plan shall include the following terms. A, the minimal requirements outlined under the existing security plan shall

remain in effect unless otherwise outlined below.

B, requirements that all patrons shall be subject to search by metal detecting wands and physical examination of any bags or purses brought into the establishment with subsequent pat down searches being supplemental as necessary.

C, requirements for preserving a crime scene or scene of a violent incident, including that the licensee shall cooperate with any investigations conducted by MPD or ABRA and that their employees shall stay and be interviewed by MPD. In the event that a crime has occurred, the licensee agrees to submit a list of all security personnel employed by the establishment which will be kept on premises with the job title or role of each employee listed, and their contact information such which shall be updated upon the hiring or termination of each security employee and shall be available at the establishment upon request by MPD or ABRA.

D, requirements that all security cameras are maintained in working order at all times, and where the respondent knows or should know that the cameras are inoperable, respondent

will follow the procedures set forth in DC Code 25-402, 403(e)(3)(g).

E, requirements that training on how to identify and handle intoxicated patrons, deescalation of threats and violence and on reporting incidents of violence and injury to the manager, security supervisor, or other appropriate authority shall be conducted biannually for all staff and security personnel and new staff and security personnel shall be trained on the security plan within 30 days of hire.

F, all staff and security officers shall be trained on the revised security plan prior to the Board's reinstatement of respondent's ABC license.

Two, security cameras. Prior to the Board lifting the suspension of the ABC license, respondent shall ensure that all 16 cameras currently in place are in full working order and that footage from all cameras is capable of being saved and maintained for at least 30 days.

Three, fine. Prior to the Board lifting the summary suspension of the ABC license, the respondent shall pay a fine in the

amount of \$2,000.00 for violations of their security plan provided, however, by entering into this offer in compromise, respondent does not admit liability for the violations. In no event shall the fine be paid later than 30 days from the Board's acceptance of this OIC.

Four, compliance walkthrough. Prior to the Board's lifting the suspension of the establishment's ABC license an ABRA investigator shall conduct a walkthrough of the licensed establishment with respondent to evaluate the establishment's compliance with the requirements outlined above.

Five, suspension. The summary ABC license suspension shall be lifted upon satisfaction of these conditions, specifically, 1), the repair of any inoperable cameras; 2), revision of the security plan; 3), training of all staff and security officers on the revised security plan; 4) successful walkthrough by ABRA; and 5) payment of the fine. And from there, it's signature lines.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bianco, it's my understanding there's an offer in compromise, and the offer in compromise was just

stated on the record by Mr. Celo. Is this your 1 2 understanding, your client's understanding of the 3 offer in compromise, sir? MR. BIANCO: Yes, sir, it is. 4 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your client aware of the fact that in an offer in 6 7 compromise, that they give up their right to a 8 hearing? 9 Yes, sir. MR. BIANCO: And is your 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 11 client also aware the fact in an offer in 12 compromise, that they give up their right to 13 appeal this matter? 14 MR. BIANCO: Yes. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Celo, I 16 have a couple of questions I want to ask you. 17 This was a summary suspension hearing, and there 18 is this offer in compromise. Is it your view 19 that if the Board moves to accept this offer in 20 compromise, that the emergency situation, that 21 while we're here today, would be addressed by the 22 terms of this offer in compromise? 23 Yes, Mr. Chair. MR. CELO: By the 24 terms of the offer in compromise, once all the

steps have been accomplished, we believe that the

emergency situation will have been resolved

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

Thank you. And you also believe that this -- if the Board moves to accept the offer in compromise, that this is in the best interest of the residents of the District of Columbia?

MR. CELO: Yes. The Government does believe that.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any questions by any Board members regarding the terms of the offer in compromise.

(No response.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

Hearing none, I'm going to make a motion that the Board accepts the offer in compromise. And I know that Mr. Celo placed the terms of the offer in compromise in the record earlier. The offer in compromise consists of five terms. Number 1, I'll just summary that they are to revise their security plan and provide that to the agency by 5:00 p.m. on April 4th, and number 2 is that there is a provision regarding security cameras, that all 16 security cameras have to be in operation and that they're capable of maintaining a recording for 30 days; number 3, there's a five

of \$2,000.00 and that should be paid before they
will be open to reopen, and I know the fine has
to be paid no later than 30 days but and
number 4, that the agency will do a walkthrough
prior to living the suspension; and number 5, the
conditions are that repair any inoperable
cameras, provision of a security plan, train up
all staff and security officers in the revised
security plan, assist with the walkthrough by
ABRA and payment of the fine. I know that I
summarized it but Mr. Celo did a great job of
putting the terms of the offer in compromise in
the record. So with that, I make a motion that
Board accept the offer in compromise. Is there a
second?
MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett
has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll
call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?
MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?
