3 CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning. We're
4 on the record. As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
5 Beverage Control Board for the District of
6 Columbia, and in accordance with DC Code Section
7 2571(f)(c) of the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I am
8 welcoming you to the regularly scheduled meeting
9 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. This
10 meeting is being conducted pursuant to guidance
11 made available by the District of Columbia's
12 Office of Open Government regarding electronic
13 meetings held by public bodies. Electronic
14 meetings by the ABC Board are also authorized
15 pursuant to Section 2577(a) of the DC Code.

16 Pursuant to the OMA requirements,

18 in advance of the meeting on ABRA's website and
19 on the District's Central Meeting Calendar. The
20 notice included the time, date, agenda, and call

20 CHAIR ANDERSON: The Board has six
21 members in attendance for the conduct of business
22 today, and that constitutes a quorum. Before we
23 get underway with this morning's calendar, I need
24 to make a few instructions very clear so that the
25 conduct of these hearings is understood by

1 everyone. There are four cases scheduled for
2 this morning's calendar. Once a case is called,
3 I will take a moment for our IT specialist to
4 elevate the rights for each party to enable their
5 camera and microphone. Then and only then will
6 you have the ability to enable your equipment.
7 If your case is not being heard, you will remain
8 mute and your camera will be disabled.

9 At the conclusion of each case, the
10 parties will have the option to leave. If the
