The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Now we're ready. Good morning everyone. My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. I would like to thank everyone for participating in ABCA's public roll call hearing via the WebEx platform provided by the DC Office of Open Government.

There are three cases on the calendar today. First case is Hen Quarter Riverpoint DC, Case No. 24-PRO-00024, Hen Quarter LLC, 2121 First Street SW, License No. ABRA-124468. This is a Retailer Class CR for a substantial change for an entertainment endorsement to have live entertainment inside the premises and outside in the summer garden.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of Hen Quarter?

MR. COPANZZI: Yes, I'm here. My name is Mark Copanzzi. I'm vice president of operations for Thompson Hospitality.

MS. FLETCHER: You're coming through a little rocky. Can you say that one more time?

MR. COPANZZI: Sure. My name is Mark Copanzzi. I am the vice president of operations for Thompson Hospitality, the parent company of Hen Quarter. Is that any better?

MS. FLETCHER: Um, only a little. If you could just say it one more time. Maybe even slower and that would help.

MR. COPANZZI: Sure. My name is Mark Copanzzi. I am the vice president of operations for Thompson Hospitality, the parent company of Hen Quarter.

MS. FLETCHER: The first name is Mark?
MR. COPANZZI: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: M-A-R-K?
MR. COPANZZI: Yes, that's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. If you could state your last name one more time and spell it for the record.

MR. COPANZZI: Copanzzi, C-O-P-A-N-Z-Z-I.

MS. FLETCHER: Copanzzi?
MR. COPANZZI: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Did you say C-A?
MR. COPANZZI: C-O-P-A-N-Z-Z-I.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very
much.
MR. COPANZZI: You're welcome.
MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 6D?

MS. KRAMER: Yes, I am. Can you hear me?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MS. KRAMER: Okay. My name is
Fredrica Kramer, K-R-A-M-E-R, first name F-R-E-D-R-I-C-A.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Kramer. At this moment I'm not sure if you're having some connectivity issues or if it's on this end. I'll see as we go along but I'm going to spell your name one more time for the court reporter because it sounds a little shaky on this end. Fredrica Kramer, K-R-A-M-E-R, first name F-R-E-D-R-I-C-A.

MS. KRAMER: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Kramer. ANC 6D does have standing as a protestant. My understanding is that the parties are in the process of finalizing a settlement agreement?

MS. KRAMER: That's correct.
MS. FLETCHER: So what's the status of that?

MS. KRAMER: Well, we -- the ANC Commission will meet on Monday, or sometime perhaps between now and Monday. We will clarify any of the outstanding issues so we may be able to resolve this when we meet on Monday. Our business meeting is April 8th for this month.

MS. FLETCHER: So is that your understanding, too, Mr. Copanzzi?

MR. COPANZZI: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Kramer, according to the information that I have, you submitted for settlement agreement to act before review already?

MS. KRAMER: Yes. The ANC submitted a -- the ANC signed a settlement agreement. There were a couple of issues in that agreement as well which may be resolved. That's not clear.

In addition to that, that settlement agreement did not contain the entertainment endorsement. That came in later. This hearing, as I understand it, is really about that, the addition of the entertainment endorsement.

MS. FLETCHER: And then --
MS. KRAMER: Sorry?
MS. FLETCHER: And then you'll
resubmit it to act before approval? Is that what you're going to do?

MS. KRAMER: Well, I don't know. I can't speak to what we'll do with the full Commission, but we would resubmit whatever that decision is, either to rule on the original protest or to agree to the addition or so forth.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.
Okay. In the meantime, I'm going to go ahead and schedule the status hearing and the protest hearing and the mediation just in case the matter is not resolved. If it is, then all of these proceedings will be cancelled.

MS. KRAMER: That's fine. Could you just repeat what you -- you're going to schedule a status hearing?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, I'm going to schedule a mediation.

MS. KRAMER: A mediation.
MS. FLETCHER: A status hearing and a protest hearing.

MS. KRAMER: Okay. That's fine. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: And I'm going to give you the dates for the status and protest hearing
first.
MS. KRAMER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: The status hearing is scheduled for May 1st of 2024 at 10:30 a.m.

MS. KRAMER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: The protest hearing is set for June 5, 2024, at 1:30 p.m.

MS. KRAMER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: And I will give you the next available date for mediation.

MS. KRAMER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Which is -- let's see here. The next available day for mediation is April 8th.

MS. KRAMER: April the 8th?
MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh. April 8. Monday, April 8 at 11:30 or 1:30. That's the next available day. When are you going to vote?

MS. KRAMER: We meet that night so do you want to do it after that?

MS. FLETCHER: Let me change it. Thank you. We'll change it to Thursday April 11th, anytime between 10:30 and 1:30.

MS. KRAMER: And do we have to tell you or how does that work?

MS. FLETCHER: Yeah, we're going to set the date now, whatever date you and Mr. Copanzzi are available. Then if the matter is resolved, we'll cancel the mediation, the status, and protest hearing. Right now we're just picking a date for mediation on whichever date you both are available.

MS. KRAMER: Let me -- you want me to -- I'm sorry. I wrote it down wrong. Thursday the 11th?

MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh. Thursday, April 11, anytime between 10:30 and 1:30.

MS. KRAMER: Okay. I don't know who -- that's fine with me. According to my calendar that's fine. I don't know if Mr. Copanzzi --

MR. COPANZZI: Anytime is fine. I'll make it work.

MS. KRAMER: Okay, that great. Thank you very much.

MS. FLETCHER: Let's just make it
Thursday, April 11 at 10:30.
MS. KRAMER: 10:30. You got it.
Thank you very much.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. I will send you a WebEx invitation to attend the
mediation as well.
MS. KRAMER: Okay. That's great. I just -- do you need anything else from me or is it just the three dates you have given me?

MS. FLETCHER: I don't need anything else.

MS. KRAMER: Okay. Thank you.
MS. HALL: Could you please repeat the time for the status hearing if you don't mind?

MS. FLETCHER: Yes. That's 10:30 a.m.
MS. HALL: Okay. Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you, Ms. Hall. You make a note that you're present as well. Ms. Hall, would you spell your name for the record, please?

MS. HALL: D-E-I-D-R-E, last name H-A-L-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
MS. HALL: Um-hum.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. If there are no more questions, I'm going to conclude the roll call hearing in this matter. If the matter is resolved prior to mediation, we'll cancel the mediation. Once the settlement agreement is submitted, the status and protest hearing will be
cancelled as well. Any questions about any of that?

Well, thank you for coming. The roll call hearing in this matter is concluded.

MS. KRAMER: Thank you. Good morning. Thank you.
