5	Good morning, everyone. My name is
6	Laverne Fletcher conducting the roll call
7	hearings as the Board's Agent in accordance with

15	This is a Retailer Class C CT for a
16	substantial change for an entertainment for live
17	entertainment inside the premises.
18	The protest issues are adverse impact
19	on peace, order, and quiet.
20	My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting
21	the roll call hearing as the Board's Agent.

23	establishment?
24	MS. MANALLE: Hi, good morning, Ms.

4	Ms. Mahmoud.
5	Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 1B?
6	MR. LAKATOS: Santiago Lakatos, S-A-N-
7	T-I-A-G-O, Lakatos, L-A-K-A-T-O-S, present on
8	behalf of ANC 1B.
9	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Lakatos.
10	Let me ask you something, are you
11	going to be the designated representative going
12	forward?
13	MR. LAKATOS: Yes, I will be. This is
14	my district.
15	MS. FLETCHER: Can you give me your
16	email address?
17	MR. LAKATOS: Sure, my email address

20	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

22	MS. MANALLE: Ms. Fletcher, is it okay
23	if we push it out one week? We're hopeful that
24	we can enter into a settlement agreement.
25	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, then, how about,

	let's see, this hearing is May status hearing
2	is May 3. What about the 25th of April?
3	MS. MANALLE: That's great with us if
4	it works with the ANC.
5	MS. FLETCHER: Is that good?
6	MR. LAKATOS: Unfortunately for that
7	time slot, I would not be able to get out of a
8	recurring work conflict at that hour. Is there
9	any other time of day that week that would be
10	possible, Ms. Fletcher?
11	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, we could do it on
