4	is Case No. 22-PRO-00009, Good Food Markets,

6	Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please elevate	
7	the rights of the parties in this case in Good	
8	Food Markets?	
9	MS. FASHBAUGH: Please stand by.	
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
11	MS. FASHBAUGH: Patricia Janifer, your	
12	rights have been elevated. Philip Sambol, your	
13	rights have been elevated. That is all, Mr.	
14	Chair.	
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	
16	Thank you.	
17	All right. Good morning from one end.	
18	Let's start with the Licensee. Could you please	
19	spell and state your name for the record, please?	
20	MR. SAMBOL: Hello. My name is Philip	
21	Sambol. That's P-H-I-L-I-P, S-A-M-B-O-L. And	
22	I'm the manager at Good Food Markets.	
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.	
24	And let's have	
25	MR. SAMBOL: Good morning.	

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Let's have the 1 2 Protestant. Please spell and state your name for 3 the record, please. 4 MS. JANIFER: Okay. My name is 5 Patricia Janifer. That's P-A-T-R-I-C-I-A. Last name is J-A-N-I-F-E-R. And I'm Commissioner for 6 7 8D07 ANC. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning. 9 Thank you. 10 All right. Mr. Sambol, you said 11 you're the manager. Can you explain -- you said 12 -- are you in the ownership, sir? You're on 13 mute, sir. 14 MR. SAMBOL: I apologize. Yes. I 15 mean manager in the corporate sense. Good Food 16 Markets is -- yeah. 17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 18 That's fine. 19 All right. Are there any preliminary matters in this case that needs to be brought to 20 21 the Board's attention, Mr. Sambol, meaning that 22 are there any issues that -- not substance, but 23 are there any issues that you have that the Board 24 can assist you with?

MR. SAMBOL: No, sir. I don't think

so. We had a preliminary meeting with Commissioner Janifer and the ABRA representative last month. And we're prepared to attempt to come to some sort of settlement and are aligned with the ANC in the concerns for community safety and issues around safe and responsible alcohol sales.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
Thank you.

Ms. Janifer, any preliminary matters, just not substantive, just issues or anything that the Board can help the parties with?

MS. JANIFER: I do have just one question. I was actually trying to obtain the actual application for the license. Can you all assist me with that?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You mean the application. I'm not sure what information. But please reach out to, you can reach out to our Agency, reach out to Sarah Fashbaugh. And whatever information that -- and this is for both parties. Whatever information that we can provide to you we can provide. She is our community liaison in the Agency, for the Agency. And so whatever information that, at least that

type of information, you can reach out to her, and she can provide you with that information.

I can't -- if that's information that's normally provided, then we will provide it. I don't know if that is something that's normally provided. But we can provide that to you.

And our -- I will also -- you could also contact -- I'm sorry. Hold on. You could also contact Ms. Imani Moreland. And both sides can do that. Ms. Moreland, her phone number is 202-442-6942. And she can provide you, because she's going to -- she will be in contact with both parties through this process, Imani Moreland at 202-442-6942. Okay?

I'm sorry. All right. Hold on. Let me -- all right. If you need records also, let me -- and I don't have the phone number for our records manager. But our records manager is Mr. Lamont Mahone. He's our records manager. So, if you call the general number for the Agency and just ask for our records manager, Mr. Lamont Mahone, he will be able to provide you whatever records you need for this case. Okay?

MS. JANIFER: Thank you very much.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You're welcome.

This matter then is scheduled for a

protest hearing on May 4, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. All

right.

Now that we have scheduled this matter for a protest hearing, there are a few things that I would like to instruct you about because the Board's practices under the COVID restrictions have changed. And although -- yeah, under the COVID restrictions, that's what brought a lot of these changes towards the operation of the Agency.

As you know, the Board's hearings are conducted virtually. So it is more important than ever that protest hearings are focused and address only those issues that are being protested.

Following this hearing, you will receive an email from ABRA legal assistant, Imani Moreland, that will include a copy of the protest information form, PIF, and a copy of the exhibit form, as well as specific instructions for the hearing.

You are required to complete and submit the PIF and exhibit forms at least seven

days before the hearing. If we do not receive a copy of your forms seven days before the hearing, your application on your protest may be subject to dismissal. These documents need to be submitted to ABRA legal and to the opposing parties.

Please know that these documents have great interest to the Board and narrows the protest issues, facilitating the process of keeping the parties on point during the hearing.

Each side is also limited to no more than 5 witnesses and will only have 60 minutes to present your case. This includes all direct and cross examinations. The Board does not intend to hear testimony on matters that are not relevant to these issues that are being protested.

Are there any questions by the parties?

MS. JANIFER: No.

MR. SAMBOL: No.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We thank you greatly for your cooperation. If you have any questions at any time leading up to the hearing, please do not hesitate to contact Ms. Moreland at 202-442-6942.
