3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're going to
4 call a case, move up a case. I'm going to call
5 Case No. 21-251-00018, Mirror Lounge, License No.
6 111950. This matter was scheduled for this
7 afternoon at 1:30, but I believe that the parties
8 have agreed to move this case to this time.

9 So, Ms. Fashbaugh, can you please
10 elevate the rights of the Government in this
11 case? I see that the Licensee is already on
12 line. So can you please elevate the rights I
13 believe of Mr. Antoine Williams, who is the
14 Licensee?

15 MS. FASHBAUGH: This has been
16 accomplished.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very
18 much.

19 I want to thank the parties for --
20 this matter was scheduled for, on our afternoon
21 calendar for 1:30. But I was informed that the
22 parties wanted to address this case earlier this
23 morning.

24 So let's have the parties introduce
25 themselves for the record starting with the

1 Government.

2 MR. WILLIAMS: Good morning, Mr.
3 Chairperson. My name is Antoine Williams on
4 behalf of the District this morning.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
6 Mr. Williams.

7 Ms. Yohannes, can you please spell and
8 state your name for the record, please?

9 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on
10 behalf of the Licensee. And that's S-I-D-O-N, Y-
11 O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
13 Mr. Williams, this matter was scheduled for a
14 show cause hearing this afternoon. Do we have a
15 show cause hearing, or are there any preliminary
16 matters?

17 MR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Chairperson, Ms.
18 Sidon has informed me this morning that she is
19 willing to accept an OIC compromise. So we've
20 agreed for an OIC regarding the matter before the
21 Board this morning. I can read that into the
22 record for you.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, please.
24 What are the terms of the OIC, please?

25 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay. So the terms of

1 the OIC are, it's a \$1,000 fine within 120 days
2 or we establish this license shall be suspended
3 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Thank
5 you, Mr. Williams.

6 Ms. Yohannes, it is my understanding
7 that there is an offer in compromise and the
8 offer in compromise, that there is a fine of
9 \$1,000 to be paid within 120 days. If the fine
10 is not paid within 120 days, the license will be
11 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
12 paid. Is this your understanding of the offer in
13 compromise?

14 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client
16 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise
17 that they're giving up their right to a hearing?

18 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client
20 also aware that by accepting an offer in
21 compromise that they've giving up their right to
22 appeal this matter?

23 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,
25 I make a motion that the offer in compromise of

1 the fine of \$1,000 to be paid within 120 days, if
2 the fine has not been paid within 120 days, the
3 license will be suspended indefinitely until the
4 fine has been paid. Is there a second?

5 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett
6 seconds.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett
8 has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll
9 call vote on the motion.

10 Mr. Short.

11 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. And I
12 agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato.

14 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett.

16 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I
17 agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen.

19 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis.

21 You're on mute, Mr. Grandis.

22 MEMBER GRANDIS: I agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

24 I agree. The matter passed 6-0-0.

25 I would like to thank the parties for

1 agreeing to move this matter up from this
2 afternoon to this morning and also for agreeing
3 to an offer in compromise. Thank you very much.
4 That's been approved. And have a great day.

5 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

6 MR. WILLIAMS: Thank you.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The matter --
8 the Board has now dispensed with its morning
9 calendar. We will be, we will now -- the Board
10 will now be in recess until 1:30 p.m. this
11 afternoon. And I will ask all Board members to
12 return to executive session for further action.
13 Good morning. And thank you very much.
