3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, the
4 next case in our calendar was Case Number 22-PRO-
5 00019 Tap 99, License Number 116883. I was
6 informed earlier that the protestants in this
7 case was running late. Hopefully they are now
8 here.

9 So we're here for Tap 99, Ms.
10 Fashbaugh.

11 MS. FASHBAUGH: Unfortunately, nobody
12 is present for Tap 99. Thank you.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
14 we're going to move on, and I will recall this
15 case. I was informed by legal that they were
16 running late, so Ms. Fashbaugh, if you see them
17 online please alert me and I will recall that
18 case.

19 But I will give them a reasonable
20 period of time to show up since I was informed
21 that they were running late.

22 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
23 went off the record at 11:22 a.m. and resumed at
24 12:02 p.m.)

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, I'm

1 going to call this case one more time, Case
2 Number -- I'm going to move back because we're at
3 the end of our morning calendar, so I'm going to
4 recall Case Number 22-PRO-00014, Tap 99, License
5 Number 116883.

6 Ms. Fashbaugh, just one last time, is
7 there anyone online for Tap 99, LLC?

8 MS. FASHBAUGH: Sorry Chairperson,
9 nobody's joined us.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
11 thank you. I then make a motion that we dismiss
12 this, this is a substantial change request, and
13 also the substantial change, it was a change of
14 hours of operation, sales, service, and
15 consumption and that was being protested.

16 And that was being protested by Frank
17 Ren (phonetic), and, this is a group of five that
18 was protesting this particular matter. So I make
19 a motion that we dismiss the application and that
20 we dismiss the protest. Is there a second?

21 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
23 seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call
24 vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

25 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

2 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

4 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
5 agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

7 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

9 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I
10 agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

12 Anderson, I agree. The matter will pass six,
13 zero, zero. So we have voted to dismiss the
14 application and we have also voted to dismiss the
15 protest.

16 The board will issue an order to the
17 applicant and the protestant will have ten days
18 to provide the agency with reasonable cause why
19 they failed to be present today.

20 Applicant responds from both sides,
21 from either side to provide us reasonable notice
22 why they were absent today.

23 The board order will take effect to
24 dismiss the application for substantial change,
25 change of hours of operation, sales, service, and

1 consumption, and the protest.

2 All right, thank you. So we're now
3 dismissed of our morning calendar.
