CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will now do our Agenda items for the morning. The first Agenda item that we will go through this morning is the Licensing Agenda. The first matter on our Licensing Agenda is the review of an Offer-InCompromise in lieu of a hearing dated April 17, 2024 for Case Number 23-CMP-00072, Culture/Vera, License Number 118175.

The Offer-In-Compromise is as follows. Charge 1, Exceeded Approved Occupancy, Primary (inaudible) Violation, Statutory Authority, D.C. Code Section 25762B1. There is a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I therefore make a motion that the Offer-In-Compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

Charge 3, failed to ensure cameras were operational, Statutory Authority D.C. Code Section 25836G1. The outcome a warning, and enforcement will conduct a walkthrough to ensure all cameras are operational. I therefore make a motion that the Offer-In-Compromise be accepted. Is there a second?
