3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will now do  
4 our Agenda items for the morning. The first  
5 Agenda item that we will go through this morning  
6 is the Licensing Agenda. The first matter on our  
7 Licensing Agenda is the review of an Offer-In-  
8 Compromise in lieu of a hearing dated April 17,  
9 2024 for Case Number 23-CMP-00072, Culture/Vera,  
10 License Number 118175.

11 The Offer-In-Compromise is as follows.  
12 Charge 1, Exceeded Approved Occupancy, Primary  
13 (inaudible) Violation, Statutory Authority, D.C.  
14 Code Section 25762B1. There is a fine of  
15 \$1,000.00 payable within 30 days or the license  
16 shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine  
17 has been paid. I therefore make a motion that  
18 the Offer-In-Compromise be accepted. Is there a  
19 second?

9 used for unlawful purpose, Statutory Authority

10 D.C. Code Section 2582382. This charge has been

11 dismissed. Charge 2, failed to follow security

12 plans, Statutory Authority D.C. Code Section

13 25823A6. There is a \$2,000.00 fine payable

14 within 30 days or the license shall be suspended

15 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

16 Charge 3, failed to ensure cameras were

17 operational, Statutory Authority D.C. Code

18 Section 25836G1. The outcome a warning, and

19 enforcement will conduct a walkthrough to ensure

20 all cameras are operational. I therefore make a

21 motion that the Offer-In-Compromise be accepted.

18 Boy Jim. This is the restaurant license located  
19 at 709 8th Street, N.E., the license number is  
20 087903. The next licensee is Smash Burger Number  
21 138. The license number is 117669, and they are  
22 located at 804 7th Street, N.W. They have  
23 requested cancellation. Amazon Fresh, License  
24 Number 116761. They are located at 1733 14th  
25 Street, N.W. They have requested a cancellation.

1 The next establishment is Kazera Lounge, License  
2 Number 117490. They are out of business. The  
3 last establishment is Poppin Mess Champagne and  
4 Dessert Bar, License Number 126665. This is  
5 their caterer's license at 1301 U Street, N.W.  
6 The regulations dictate that the licensee may not  
7 hold both a caterer's license and a  
8 manufacturer's license simultaneously, so we will  
9 be cancelling the caterer's license.

10 I therefore make a motion that the  
11 Board cancels all the licensees that were read in  
12 the record. Is there a second?

13 first, second and third year payments for  
14 endorsement. The next establishment is Etto, E-  
15 T-T-O, License Number 088504. The licensee did  
16 not pay the first, second and third year payments  
17 for the endorsement. The next establishment is  
18 D.C. Conscious Caf,, License Number 088623. The  
19 licensee did not pay the third year payment for  
20 the entertainment endorsement. The next  
21 establishment is Harvest Kite Steak House,  
22 License Number 118108. The licensee did not pay  
23 the second and third year payment for  
24 entertainment endorsement. The next  
25 establishment is Buscelli's Itallian Deli,

1 License Number 118868. The Licensee did not pay  
2 the second and third year payment for the summer  
3 garden endorsement. The last establishment is  
4 Caf, Unido, U-N-I-D-O, License Number 119297.  
5 The licensee did not pay the third year payment  
6 for the summer garden endorsement. I therefore  
7 make a motion that the ABC Board issues cease and  
8 desist orders to the establishments that were  
9 just read in the record. Is there a second?
