I'm the 3 4 CEO and owner of Relva Dispensary. 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, sir. 6 7 Mr. Prince, can you please spell and 8 state your name for the record? 9 MR. PRINCE: Good morning. My name is 10 spelled D-A-L-E, P-R-I-N-C-E. I'm the Advisory 11 Neighborhood Commissioner for Single Member District 6E-08. 12 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So this is a protest hearing status for a -- I believe this is 14 15 a cannabis, medical cannabis dispensary. Is that 16 correct? 17 MR. JENNINGS: Yes, it is. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are 19 there any preliminary matters that need to be 20 brought to the attention of the Board? We're not 21 asking for any substantive, but like any 2.2 procedural type of problems that you have been 23 having so far, Mr. Jennings? 24 MR. JENNINGS: I wouldn't say any 25 issues. We just are -- haven't came to agreement

1 yet with the ANC Board. I feel like we're 2 probably about like 80 percent there. Me and Dale have came into communication for a little 3 over a month now and we've been going back and 4 forth trying to come up with a agreement. 5 I think that -- I think that a big 6 7 problem is is that we still all learning 8 different stuff with the consumption lounge 9 rules. And as we're learning as we go, that's why I feel like we haven't came up with a 10 11 Settlement Agreement yet. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 13 Thank you for that representation. 14 Mr. Prince, and again not substantive, 15 just any preliminary matters that you want to 16 bring to the attention of the Board? 17 MR. PRINCE: No, nothing to add. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 19 Fine. Thank you for that. 20 If this matter is not settled, then 21 this will be scheduled for a protest hearing on May 22nd at 1:30 p.m. 2.2 23 Let me provide some instructions to 24 the parties because protest hearings on cannabis 25 on dispensaries are still new to the Board. It's

still new to everyone and so it's a learning process.

All right. So as I stated before, if this matter goes to a hearing it's scheduled for May 22nd at 1:30 p.m.

Now that we have scheduled this matter for a protest hearing, there are a few things that I would like to intrust the Applicant and the Protestants about so that the protest hearing is focused and addresses only those issues that are being protested.

The Board does not intend to hear 12 13 testimony on matters that are not relevant to 14 this case. You should have received by 15 electronic or regular mail a letter explaining 16 the protest process, a copy of the Protest Information Form, and a copy of the exhibit form. 17 18 If you do not have these documents, please contact our legal office following the hearing. 19

It is imperative that you review the rules closely and adhere to them before and during the protest hearing. You are also required to complete and submit the Protest Information Form, PIF, and the exhibit form seven days before the date of the hearing. These two

forms and accompanying documents need to be submitted to ABRA's legal division and to all opposing parties in this matter.

If we do not receive a copy of your 4 5 PIF, your application, or your protest, whichever side you're representing, may be subject to 6 7 dismissal. Likewise, if we do not receive a copy 8 of the exhibit form and the exhibits themselves, 9 your exhibits may be excluded from the record 10 upon a finding that the opposing party has been 11 prejudiced or no good cause for failure to submit has been shown. 12

13 Likewise, witnesses other than a party 14 may also be subject to exclusion if not 15 identified on the PIF. Accordingly, these forms 16 are very important. They greatly assist the 17 Board in narrowing the protest issues, 18 facilitating the process, and keeping the parties 19 on point during the hearing. They likewise 20 provide notice to the opposing parties enabling 21 them to better prepare for the hearing.

Also, as you're aware, all our hearings are now conducted virtually. You will have one hour to present your case and you'll only be allowed to call five witnesses. If you

15	forward. Again, if this matter is going to a
16	hearing, it is imperative that seven days before
17	the hearing documents and witnesses are
18	exchanged. That is very important that that is
19	done.
20	If the parties believe that this
21	matter can truly be settled, the Board is open to
22	accept settlement as soon as possible. But if
23	you believe that this case can truly be settled,
24	please advise the agency so we do not have to
25	assign an investigator to write a report.
