15	protest issues are adverse impact on peace,		
16	order, and quiet, and residential parking needs,		
17	and vehicular and pedestrian safety.		
18	Is there anyone present on behalf of		
19	Medusa Lounge? Is there anyone present on behalf		
20	of Medusa Lounge? The time is approximately		
21	10:05. We allow 10 minutes for all parties to		
22	appear in the case if they are experiencing any		
23	technical difficulties.		
24	Is anyone here on behalf of ANC-1E?		
25	MR. JACOBSON: Yes. This is Josh

1 Jacobson, member of ANC-1E for 1E06. 2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. 3 Jacobson. Would you spell your name for the record, please? 4 5 MR. JACOBSON: J-A-C-O-B-S-O-N. MS. FLETCHER: 6 Mr. Jacobson, we're 7 going to wait for an additional five minutes 8 before we proceed to give the Applicant time to 9 show up. 10 MR. JACOBSON: Sounds good. Thank 11 you. 12 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to check my 13 emails to make sure he hasn't tried to contact 14 me. 15 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went off the record at 10:06 a.m. and resumed at 10:10 16 17 a.m.) 18 MS. FLETCHER: The time is approximately 10:10. There's no one present on 19 20 behalf of the Applicant and I have not received 21 any communication from the Applicant indicating 2.2 that he was not able to join today. Therefore, 23 the license renewal application is dismissed. 2.4 What that means, Mr. Jacobson, is that 25 the ABC Board will issue an order dismissing the

application. Upon receipt of the order the Applicant will have 10 days to seek reinstatement of the application providing the Board with a good cause for why he was not present today.

5 With respect to the protest filed by 6 ANC-1E, Mr. Jacobson, I read your protest letter 7 and there were some deficiencies in the letter. 8 I'll tell you what they are. As a result of 9 those, the protest will have to be dismissed, but 10 let me tell you why.

When an ANC files a protest letter, the protest letter has to state that a regularly scheduled publicly noticed hearing was held concerning the application, that there was a quorum present, and that a vote was taken by the ANC to protest the application.

That may have been done. If that was done, you can inform the ABC Board and provide them with the evidence you have that was actually done. For those reasons, the protest is dismissed because those are requirements for a protest filed by an ANC.

23 MR. JACOBSON: Okay. That was done so 24 I'll just double check that there weren't any 25 issues with the transmission of the letter and

If they grant you standing 14 as a protestant, we won't need to have the roll 15 call hearing again because that's one of the 16 purposes of the roll call hearing is to determine 17 who has standing as a protestant. 18 MR. JACOBSON: Got it. Okay. 19 MS. FLETCHER: We will just start with 20 mediation 21 MR. JACOBSON: That sounds good. 2.2 MS.
