3 MS. FLETCHER: The next hearing on the
4 calendar is M Street Entertainment, LLC, trade
5 name to be determined.

6 The Case Number is 22-PRO-00024, 3123
7 through 3125 M Street, Northwest, License Number
8 ABRA-119608.

9 This is a Retailer Class CR,
10 substantial change for sports wagering, to place
11 ten wagering kiosks and one wagering window
12 inside the premises. The protest issues are
13 adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

14 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
15 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is
16 anyone present on behalf of the Applicant?

17 MR. MINORA: Yes. My name is Matthew
18 Minora from the law firm of Mallios, O'Brien and
19 Sandground. And we're ABC license counsel to the
20 Applicant.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Minora, would you
22 spell your name for the record, please?

23 MR. MINORA: Sure. Matthew is M-A-T-
24 T-H-E-W. Minora is M-I-N-O-R-A.

25 MS. FLETCHER: And so Mr. Minora,

1 you're going to need to spell the name of the law
2 firm.

3 MR. MINORA: Oh, sure. Okay. M-A-L-
4 L-I-O-S, and O'Brien is O- apostrophe B-R-E -- B-
5 R-I-E-N, and then Sandground is S-A-N-D-G-R-O-U-
6 N-D.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
8 And present on behalf of ANC 2E?

9 MS. PALMER: Good morning, it's Lisa
10 Palmer.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Ms.
12 Palmer. Would you please spell your name for the
13 record, please?

14 MS. PALMER: Sure. L-I-S-A, and the
15 last name is Palmer, P-A-L-M-E-R.

16 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 2E does have
17 standing as a protestant. We need to set a date
18 for mediation, a status hearing, and a protest
19 hearing.

20 I'll give you the dates for the status
21 and protest hearings first. The status hearing
22 is scheduled for May 25. May 25, 2022 at 10:30
23 a.m.

24 The protest hearing is set for July 13
25 at 1:30. The next available day for mediation is

1 Wednesday, May 4, any time between 9:00 a.m. and
2 1:30.

3 MR. MINORA: If it's okay with
4 Commissioner Palmer, I was going to suggest that
5 we push the mediation closer to the status
6 hearing date, because we'll tend to be able to
7 work through the details of the settlement
8 agreement before that.

9 MS. PALMER: That makes sense.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. In that case,
11 what about Monday, May 23. Is that too far out?

12 MR. MINORA: Nope. That should be
13 fine, I think.

14 MS. PALMER: That works for me.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Then what about Monday,
16 May 23, at 11:30?

17 MS. PALMER: Great.

18 MR. MINORA: That works for me as
19 well.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Mediation is set
21 for Monday, May 23, at 11:30. And let me know if
22 I need to cancel it.

23 MR. MINORA: Okay.

24 MS. FLETCHER: And thank you for --

25 MS. PALMER: Great.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for coming.

2 MS. PALMER: Thank you.

3 MR. MINORA: Thank you.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Enjoy the rest
5 of your day.

6 MS. PALMER: Sure. Bye-bye.

7 MR. MINORA: Bye-bye.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Bye-bye. The roll call
9 hearing in this matter is concluded.
