7	This is a Retailer Class CT,
8	substantial change application for an
9	entertainment endorsement.
10	The protest issues are adverse impact
11	on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking,
12	and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and real
13	property values.
14	My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting

3	MR. BERNSTEIN: Yes, ma'am.
4	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
5	Is anyone else from your group present today?
6	MR. BRIDGES: Uh, yeah.
7	MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone else present
8	today from the group of 12?
9	MR. BRIDGES: Yeah. Yes.
10	MS. FLETCHER: Could you state your
11	name and spell it for the record, please?
12	MR. BRIDGES: Yes, David Bridges, and
13	that's D-A-V-I-D, the last name B-R-I-D-G-E-S.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Bridges.
15	Anyone else?
16	(No response)
17	MS. FLETCHER: There are two
18	individuals present from the group of 12, which
19	means that the group of 12 is granted conditional
20	standing.
21	At this point, I'm not going to
22	schedule any dates. But, if there are going to
23	be any upcoming dates, Mr. Bernstein, that will
24	include a status hearing at which at least three
25	more individuals would need to appear in person.

	In order to be granted full standing,
2	the Board needs to see at least five people in
3	person. Two are present today.
4	If there's going to be a status
5	hearing, three more people from the group would
6	need to appear that did not appear today.
7	MR. BERNSTEIN: Understood.
8	Apologies, ma'am. It's difficult to schedule peo
9	we are all all work, you know, during the
10	week.
11	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
12	MR. BERNSTEIN: So, it's it's,
13	yeah, difficult.
14	MS. FLETCHER: It's not a problem at
15	all. We only need one person from the group to
16	appear.
17	That would have that would have
18	been sufficient. So, the fact that two of you
19	are here, it's fine.
20	Is anyone present on behalf of Toro
21	Bar?

23	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Bernstein, have you
24	had any communication with the Applicant at all?
25	MR. BERNSTEIN: Not not in quit, in

some quit, quit some time, ma'am. 1 2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. The 3 Application is dismissed because the Applicant is 4 not present. 5 Mr. Bernstein, what that means is that there will be a Board Order issued to dismiss the 6 7 Application, because the Applicant is not present 8 today. 9 The Applicant will have ten days upon 10 receipt of the Board Order, to explain to the 11 Board why she's not present today. 12 You will be kept informed. You'll 13 receive a copy of the Order. If the Applicant 14 does seek reinstatement, you'll have an 15 opportunity to be opposed to that as well. 16 But, for now, the Application is 17 There are no upcoming dates. dismissed. 18 Board decides to grant reinstatement of the 19 Application, you'll be contacted to schedule 20 mediation by me. 21 And you'll receive notice regarding a 22 status and the protest hearing.
