3 MS. FLETCHER: I am going to go ahead
4 and call up the matter of Signature Lounge since
5 all the parties are present. This is Case Number
6 21-PRO-00017, Aberash LLC, trading as Signature
7 Lounge, 1727 Connecticut Avenue NW, License
8 Number ABRA 117485. This is a retailer Class CT
9 new application. The protest issues are adverse
10 impact on peace, order, and quiet.

11 If you're not speaking would you please
12 mute your microphone, if you're not speaking.
13 Thank you.

14 My name is Laverne Fletcher. I'll be
15 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
16 agent. Present on behalf of the Applicant,
17 please.

18 MR. LOCH: Nicholas Loch on behalf of
19 the Applicant.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Loch, would you
21 please spell your name for the record?

22 MR. LOCH: It's N-I-C-H-O-L-A-S L-O-C-
23 H.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And
25 present on behalf ANC 2B?

1 MS. ROGGENSACK: Meg Roggensack, I am
2 the Commissioner in ANC's Single Member District
3 2B01. My last name is R-O-G-G-E-N-S-A-C-K.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And
5 present on behalf of the Dupont Circle Citizens
6 Association?

7 MR. ENGELMANN: Glenn Engelmann. My
8 name is spelled G-L-E-N-N, last name, E-N-G-E-L-
9 M-A-N-N.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. ANC
11 2B and the Dupont Circle Citizens Association
12 have standing as protestants. We need to
13 schedule a date for mediation, and then I'll give
14 you the dates for the status and the protest
15 hearing.

16 The next available date for mediation is
17 Tuesday, May 4, anytime between 10:00 and 2:30 in
18 the afternoon. Is May 4 good for anybody or
19 everybody?

20 MR. LOCH: May 4 is good for us. This
21 is Nicholas.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And who was that
23 speaking?

24 MR. LOCH: The Applicant.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

1 MR. ENGELMANN: Yes, same for DCCA.

2 MS. ROGGENSACK: This is Meg Roggensack,
3 I could be available before noon on the 4th.

4 MS. FLETCHER: So, Meg, what about 10:00
5 a.m. on May 4?

6 MS. ROGGENSACK: Yes, that's fine.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Would that work for
8 everybody?

9 MR. ENGELMANN: Yes.

10 MS. ROGGENSACK: How much time is going
11 to be allocated for this?

12 MS. FLETCHER: There is no particular
13 amount of time allocated. We take as long as we
14 need.

15 Excuse me, please. I'm going to get you
16 the date for the status and protest hearings.
17 Give me one second.

20 not able to access those dates. But as soon as
21 the roll call hearings are over, I will send the
22 dates to you for the status hearing and the
23 protest hearing.

24 MR. ENGELMANN: Okay, thank you.

25 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome. Any

1 questions, anyone?

2 Okay, well, thank you for coming. The
3 roll call hearing is concluded for Signature
4 Lounge.

8 MS. ROGGENSACK: Excuse me, Ms.
9 Fletecher, this is Meg Roggensack. I lost

14 MS. ROGGENSACK: I lost connectivity
15 before I heard the status and protest hearing for

21 and protest hearing. You didn't miss them.
