MEMBER GRANT: Good afternoon. We're on the record. As Chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board for the District of Columbia and in accordance with D.C. Official Code Section 2.571 et. seq. of the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I am welcoming you to the regular scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board.

This meeting is being conducted pursuant to guidance made available by the District of Columbia's Office of Open Government regarding electronic meetings held by public bodies. Electronic meetings by the ABC Board are authorized pursuant to Section 2.577a of D.C. Code.

Pursuant to the OMA requirements notice of today's meeting was provided 48 hours in advance of the meeting on ABCA's website and on the District's Central Meeting Calendar. The notice includes the time, date, agenda, and call-in or log-in information for public participation.

5 My name is Donovan Anderson. I'm
6 Chairperson of the Board. I would like to
7 introduce the other members of the ABC Board who
8 are also participating electronically. Please
9 respond when I announce your names.

10 Mr. Silas Grant?

11 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Silas Grant.

12 Present.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. David

14 Meadows?

15 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. David Meadows.

16 Present.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Ryan Jones?

18 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Ryan Jones.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The Board has
20 four members in attendance for the conduct of
21 business today and that constitutes a quorum.

22 We do not have a early morning,
23 afternoon calendar, so what we're going to do now
24 is our agenda items for the early afternoon.

25 The first agenda that we're going to

1 address today, it's our legal agenda, alcohol.

2 No. 1 on the agenda is review of a
3 Settlement Agreement. This is for Lounge U,
4 License No. 130300. I make a motion that we
5 approve this agreement. Is there a second?

6 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second
7 the motion.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
9 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
10 vote.

11 Mr. Grant?

12 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

14 MEMBER MEADOWS: (No audible
15 response.)

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I cannot hear
17 you, Mr. Meadows.

18 MEMBER MEADOWS: Apologies. Mr.
19 Meadows. I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

21 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
23 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

24 No. 2, review of Settlement Agreement.
25 This is for Taporì, License No. 131196. I make a

1 motion that we approve this agreement. Is there
2 a second?

3 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
4 second the motion.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
6 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
7 vote. Mr. Grant?

8 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

10 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
11 agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

13 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
15 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

16 No. 3, review of a request to extend
17 protest petition deadline. This is for Kathmandu
18 Tapas & Cocktails, License No. 132050. I make a
19 motion that we approve this request. Is there a
20 second?

21 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second
22 that request.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
24 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
25 vote. Mr. Grant?

1 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

3 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I

4 agree.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

6 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

8 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

9 No. 4, review of notice of license
10 extension of hours in May and June 2025, D.C.
11 Official Code Section 25-723(g) (h). I make a
12 motion that we approve this extension of hours.
13 Is there a second?

14 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second
15 the motion.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
17 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
18 vote. Mr. Grant?

19 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

21 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I

22 agree.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

24 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

1 Anderson. I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

2 We now move to our legal agenda,
3 alcohol addendum. The first matter on our legal
4 agenda is an Offer in Compromise. This is for
5 Case No. 25-CMP-00003, Blue Moon, License No.
6 118303.

7 The Offer in Compromise is as follows:

8 Charge 1, substantial change in
9 operations without Board approval by extending
10 hours of operation. Statutory authority, D.C.
11 Code Section 25.762(b)(13). There is a \$1,000
12 fine payable within 30 days or the license shall
13 be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
14 paid. I make a motion the Offer in Compromise is
15 accepted. Is there a second?

16 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
17 second.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
19 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
20 vote. Mr. Grant?

21 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

23 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
24 agree.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

1 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

3 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

4 No. 2, review of motion for
5 reconsideration. This is for Cielo's Angels,
6 License No. 131487. I make a motion that we
7 approve this request. Is there a second?

8 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second
9 the motion.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
11 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
12 vote. Mr. Grant?

13 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

15 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
16 agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

18 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

20 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

21 No. 3, review of precipitate of
22 dismissal. This is for Citizen M/Sushi By Bou.
23 This for Case No. 24-CIT-00822. I make a motion
24 that we approve this request. Is there a second?

25 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second

1 the motion.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
3 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
4 vote. Mr. Grant?

5 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

7 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
8 agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

10 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
12 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

13 We now move to our legal agenda,
14 medical cannabis.

15 No. 1 on this agenda, it's a review of
16 an Offer in Compromise. This is for Case No. 25-
17 ULC-00028. It is Classic Tobacco/Elsha, LLC,
18 unlicensed established.

19 The Offer in Compromise is as follows:

20 Products not to be offered, exchanged,
21 or sold. Respondent confirms that it has ceased
22 selling cannabis or cannabis products and agrees
23 to not offer, exchange, or sell either in the
24 store or online the following products: cannabis
25 or cannabis-derived products including all

1 cannaboids, hemp, and CBD, kratom 3, any
2 schedule 1 substance and substances including
3 psychedelic mushrooms and dimethyltryptamine,
4 otherwise known as DMT.

5 No. 2, Remediation. To remediate the
6 licensed sale of cannabis and cannabis products
7 that occurred in the business Respondent will
8 change its business model to a legitimate
9 cigarette retail operation.

10 No. 3, Inspection. Respondent agrees
11 to allow ABCA investigators to inspect the entire
12 premises of the business during those hours that
13 it is open to the public to verify that the
14 business is not selling those products listed in
15 paragraph 1 until such time as a medical cannabis
16 retail license is issued by the ABC Board.

17 No. 4, Licensing. Notwithstanding
18 paragraph 1, nothing in this OIC precludes
19 Respondent from applying for a medical cannabis
20 retail license.

21 No. 5, Lifting of a Summary Closure.
22 The current summary closure shall remain in
23 effect until the Multi-agency Cannabis
24 Enforcement Team, MCET, has inspected the entire
25 premises.

1 I therefore make a motion that the
2 Offer in Compromise be accepted. Is there a
3 second?

4 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
5 second.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
7 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
8 vote.

9 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

11 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
12 agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

14 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
16 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

17 We now move to No. 2, review of Offer
18 in Compromise. This is for Case No. 25-ULC-
19 00026, Hotbox.

20 The Offer in Compromise is as follows:

21 Respondent affirms that it has ceased
22 all unlicensed cannabis sales on the premises and
23 online. Respondent agrees to not sell cannabis
24 and cannabis products at the premises, online, or
25 at any other location in the District of Columbia

1 without a medical cannabis retailer license.

2 Respondent agrees not to sell
3 psilocybin mushrooms or products.

4 No. 3, Respondent is not precluded
5 from proceeding with its pending medical cannabis
6 retail license application under the license name
7 Hotbox DC, LLC at the premises.

8 No. 4, the summary closure of
9 Respondent shall remain in effect while the
10 application is pending.

11 No. 5, notwithstanding the summary
12 closure being in effect, limited access to the
13 premises may be granted in ABCA's discretion to
14 contractors to prepare the premises necessary to
15 obtain a medical cannabis license. The premises
16 shall remain closed to the public while
17 construction work or modifications occur and
18 shall remain padlocked during those times that
19 construction work or modifications are not taking
20 place at the business.

21 No. 6, if Respondent is issued a
22 medical cannabis retail license the summary
23 closure shall be lifted and ABCA shall make the
24 keys to the premises available to Respondent for
25 pick up at the offices or at another mutually

1 agreed upon time, date, and location.

2 No. 7, if Respondent if denied a
3 cannabis retail license, the summary closure
4 shall remain in effect.

5 I therefore make a motion that the
6 Offer in Compromise be accepted. Is there a
7 second?

8 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second
9 the motion.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
11 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
12 vote.

13 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

15 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
16 agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

18 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
20 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

21 No. 3, review of motion to reopen
22 premises. This is District Cure. This is in
23 Case No. 25-CMP-00056. I make a motion that we
24 approve this request. Is there a second?

25 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second

1 the motion.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
3 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
4 vote.

5 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

7 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
8 agree.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

10 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
12 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

13 No. 4 is being modified, which is a
14 review of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking an
15 prorating license fees. I make a motion that the
16 proposed rulemaking be approved. Is there a
17 second?

18 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
19 second.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
21 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
22 vote.

23 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

25 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I

1 agree.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

3 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.

5 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

6 We now move to our licensing agenda.

7 On the licensing agenda there are seven items. I
8 will review all seven with recommendations. At
9 the end I'll ask the ABC Board to affirm the
10 recommendations of the Chair.

11 No. 1, review application for
12 safekeeping of license. This is for Palette
13 22/Desert 5 Spot, License No. 127013.
14 Recommendation, that we approve through September
15 30th, 2025.

16 No. 2, review application for
17 safekeeping of license. This is for Lucky Buns,
18 License No. 121405. Recommendation, approval
19 through September 30th, 2025.

20 No. 3, Review request to reinstate the
21 game of skill endorsement which was removed from
22 the license on October 25th, '23. This is for
23 Atomic Billiards, License No. 019007.
24 Recommendation, placard.

25 No. 4, review application for the game

1 of skill endorsement to place up to five consoles
2 offering the game District Edge. This is for Las
3 Delicias Restaurant & Catering, License No.
4 127367. Recommendation, placard.

5 No. 5, review application for an off-
6 site storage permit endorsement to store unopened
7 alcoholic beverage inventory off site at Made to
8 Measure Cocktails. The request is made by Union
9 Stage, License No. 106026. Recommendation,
10 approval.

11 No. 6, review application for an off-
12 site permit endorsement unopened alcoholic
13 beverage inventory off site at Made to Measure
14 Cocktails. The request is being made by Pearl
15 Street Warehouse, License No. 105098.
16 Recommendation, approval.

17 And No. 7, review application for an
18 off-site storage permit endorsement to store
19 unopened alcoholic beverage inventory off site at
20 Made to Measure Cocktails. This is for Causa,
21 License No. 114552.

22 I therefore make a motion that the ABC
23 Board approve the recommendations made by the
24 Chair for the licensing agenda. Is there a
25 second?

1 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second
2 the motion.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
4 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
5 vote.

6 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

8 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
9 agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

11 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
13 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

14 We now move to the alcohol
15 supplemental licensing agenda. There are three
16 applications on this agenda. I will review the
17 names and at the end I'll ask the ABC Board to
18 approve the recommendations as put forth by the
19 chair.

20 No. 1, review a request for a
21 temporary operating retail permit. This is for
22 Hilton Washington, D.C. Capitol Hill, License No.
23 132328. Recommendation, approval.

24 No. 2, review request for a temporary
25 operating retail permit. This is for Tall Ship

1 Providence, License No. 132356. Recommendation,
2 approval.

3 No. 3, review application for a
4 stipulated license *121941 ANC support for a new
5 ABC license. This is for Mason's Famous Lobster
6 Rolls, License No. 131653. Approval.

7 I therefore make a motion that the ABC
8 Board approve the recommendations made by the
9 Chair for the alcohol supplemental licensing
10 agenda. Is there a second?

11 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I second
12 the motion.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
14 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
15 vote.

16 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

18 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
19 agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

21 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
23 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

24 We now move to the vacated, cease, and
25 desist orders agenda. On this agenda there are

1 34 licensees. And without objection, I make a
2 motion that the ABC Board approve -- vote to
3 vacate all the applications -- I'm sorry, all the
4 licenses on the Notice of Meeting Vacated, Cease,
5 and Desist Orders Agenda for April 30th, 2025.
6 Without objection, I make a motion that we
7 approve that. Is there a second?

8 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
9 second.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows has
11 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
12 vote.

13 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

15 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
16 agree.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

18 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
20 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

21 We now move to the cancellation
22 agenda. There are 15 licenses on this agenda.
23 So I will read the names in the record and then
24 I'll ask the ABC Board members to approve the
25 recommendations.

1 The ABC Board will be cancelling the

23 licensee did not request extension.

24 No. 6, Mason's Famous Lobster Rolls,
25 License No. 120128. The license was in

1 safekeeping. It has expired and the licensee did
2 not request an extension.

3 No. 7, Slash Run, License No. 109631.
4 The license was in safekeeping. It has expired
5 and the licensee did not request an extension.

6 No. 8, Fight Club, License No. 121407.
7 The licensee requests cancellation.

8 No. 9, Angelico Pizzeria & Cafe,
9 License No. 060711. The licensee requests
10 cancellation.

11 No. 10, Dapi Liquor, License No.
12 117908. Licensee requests cancellation.

13 No. 11, Sticky Rice/Sing Sing Karaoke
14 Palace, License No. 072783. The licensee
15 requests cancellation.

16 No. 12, Noodles on 11, License No.
17 060525. The licensee requests cancellation.

18 No. 13, Sip & Tipple, License
19 No.118553. The licensee requests cancellation.

20 No. 14, McCormick & Schmick's Seafood
21 Restaurant, License No. 026432. The licensee
22 requests cancellation.

23 No. 15, Et Voila Catering, License No.
24 079032. The licensee requests cancellation.

25 And No. 16, Tastemakers, License No.

1 106587. The licensee requests cancellation.

2 I make a motion that the ABC Board
3 cancels those licensees. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I second
5 the motion.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones has
7 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
8 vote.

9 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Meadows?

11 MEMBER MEADOWS: Mr. Meadows. I
12 agree.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Jones?

14 MEMBER JONES: Mr. Jones. I agree.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson.
16 I agree. The matter passes 4-0.

17 Now let's do the Board's temporary
18 one-day and substantial change docket. There's
19 27 Applicants in this docket so I'm going to read
20 the 27 names and the type of -- the class
21 category, the event, the date, the license
22 number, and the attendees, and the
23 recommendations. And then I will ask the ABC
24 Board members to approve the recommendations made
25 by the Chair.

1 No. 1, a request from A-N-A-H-I-T-A.
2 The second name, H-O-S-S-E-I-N-I. The next name
3 is B-A-D-A-K-H-S-H-A-N-I. This is for a one-day
4 license, Class F. This is for PTS reception.
5 This is May 2nd. The License No. is 132268.
6 Three hundred, attendees, six security guards.
7 Recommendation, approval.

8 No. 2, a request from Raffi, R-A-F-F-
9 I, S-A-H-A-K-Y-A-N, for a one-day license, Class
10 F. This is for ethnic food and culture. This is
11 May 16th and May 17th. The License No. is
12 130891. A hundred attendees, two security
13 guards. Recommendation, approval.

14 No. 3, a request from Anita Ellia, E-
15 L-L-I-A, one-day license, Class F, reception.
16 This is May 13. License No. is 132318. Fifty
17 attendees, one security guard. For approval.
