3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're on the
4 record. Good afternoon, everyone. And welcome
5 to the afternoon session of the ABC Board. My
6 name is Donovan Anderson. I'm Chairperson of the
7 Board. Joining me this afternoon are two other
8 Board Members, Mr. James Short and Mr. Silas
9 Grant.

10 The Board has three members in
11 attendance for the conduct of business and that
12 constitutes a quorum.

13 Before we get underway with this
14 afternoon's calendar, I need to make a few
15 instructions very clear so that the conduct of
16 these hearings is understood by everyone.

17 There are five cases scheduled for our
18 afternoon's calendar. Once your case is called,
19 I will take a moment for IT specialist to elevate
20 the rights for each party to enable their camera
21 and microphone. Then, and only then, will you
22 have the ability to enable your equipment.

23 If your case has not been heard, you
24 will remain mute and your camera will be
25 disabled. At the conclusion of each case, the

1 parties will have the option to leave. If the
2 party chooses to stay, all cameras and microphone
3 for the concluded case will be disabled.
