3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4	on our calendar is a fact-finding hearing on Our
5	Spot Tobacco Shop, License No. 127162.
6	Good afternoon, Mr. Orellana. Can you
7	please elevate the rights of the licensee in this
8	case, and anyone else they might have joining
9	them.
10	MR. ORELLANA: Good afternoon. Anania
11	Aligaz, your access has been elevated. Jimmie
12	Jones, your access has been elevated. That
13	appears to be all, Chairman.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
15	Thank you.
16	MR. ALIGAZ: Hello. Good afternoon.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hello. Good
18	afternoon. Who is the owner of the
19	establishment? If the three of you are all
20	together, you don't need to be logged on. All
21	right. Who is the licensee?
22	MR. ALIGAZ: I am Anania Aligaz.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you spell
24	your name for the record?
25	MR. ALIGAZ: Last name is A-L-I-G-A-Z.
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1 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you are the 3 owner of this establishment, sir? MR. ALIGAZ: 4 Yes. 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The purpose of this hearing today the Agency -- it's my 6 7 understanding that the Agency has been trying --8 I'm sorry. You had applied for a license and the 9 Agency provided you two deficiency notices for you to provide additional information, but the 10 11 information was not -- at least, in our view, was 12 not provided. 13 I guess what I'm trying to find out --14 it's my understanding that there is still an 15 outstanding document missing. Are you aware what document is missing for your file, sir? 16 17 MR. ALIGAZ: Yes, she's my 18 spokesperson. Can she explain? 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And who is your spokesperson, sir? 20 21 MS. BOGALE: Hi. My name is Ethiopia 2.2 Bogale. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on, ma'am. 2.4 Can you spell your name? 25 MS. BOGALE: Sure.

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1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Spell your name
2	for the record, ma'am.
3	MS. BOGALE: Sure. It's E-T-H-I-O-P-
4	I-A, last name Bogale, B-O-G-A-L-E.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Tell us what's
6	going on, ma'am.
7	MS. BOGALE: So, yeah, we applied in
8	December and I think we have signed a licensing
9	form. Then like at that point before we after
10	we submit the application, we sent documentation
11	that we have been working unlicensed.
12	After that we didn't hear back from
13	the ABCA. Then we have like contact them. We
14	went there to their office and they asked us to
15	send some documents like pictures of the I-71
16	initiative and we did that. Then we got the
17	denial letter. Then we applied for we
18	appealed and now we are here.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But I'm saying
20	it's my understanding that there are outstanding
21	documents so are you aware what document is still
22	outstanding?
23	MS. BOGALE: No. No one told us about
24	the outstanding documents. We just figured our
25	self that this is proof we have been doing I-71
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1 compliance so we sent all the pictures to them. 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 3 But have you not received letters from the Agency? You said 4 5 you received a denial letter. is that correct? 6 MS. BOGALE: Yes. Can I explain what 7 happened? So we applied in December, right? So 8 after December in February we tried to contact to 9 get a status because we never heard anything. And then we have -- they told us to contact Mr. 10 11 Sean. We contact Mr. Sean and he told us 12 13 verbally like over the phone to send them like 14 proof that we have been doing the unlicensed. We 15 sent him the pictures and everything. Also we 16 haven't heard anything from him and we emailed 17 him. 18 After that we went to their office and 19 he told us to talk to Ms. Rubio. That's when on 20 March 26th she told us she's going to send us an 21 official denial letter and to appeal. We were 2.2 never asked about documents to submit. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But when you received the letter, the denial letter --24 25 MS. BOGALE: Yes.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: did the	
2	denial letter tell you what document was missing?	
3	MS. BOGALE: No, just to appeal and	
4	the email address to appeal. That's it.	
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So it didn't	
6	tell you why your application was denied?	
7	MS. BOGALE: No. I mean, let me	
8	double check.	
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you have the	
10	letter there you can read from it, please?	
11	MS. BOGALE: Yes, sure. Sorry. The	
12	denial letter	
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is the	
14	date of this letter, ma'am?	
15	MS. BOGALE: March 26th.	
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What does the	
17	letter state?	
18	MS. BOGALE: So it says medical	
19	cannabis retailer unlicensed application is the	
20	subject. Then it says, "Thank you for submitting	
21	your application for medical cannabis retailer	
22	license.	
23	We regret to inform you that the	
24	application was denied on January 31st and it	
25	does not meet the requirements set by the D.C.	
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1 Code 7-1671.068. The application is denied due 2 to the following issue: application does not 3 meet the criteria to be accepted as a licensed 4 operator." CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's all it 5 6 says? 7 MS. BOGALE: Yes, that's all it says. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 9 Mr. Orellana, can you upload -- were 10 you asked to upload --11 Ma'am, are you able to -- there is a 12 document in the chat. 13 MS. BOGALE: Yeah. Let me try to log 14 in. Give me a second. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you able to 15 16 copy this link, ma'am? Denial letter. 17 MS. BOGALE: 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, there was 19 a document that was just --20 MS. BOGALE: Let me check. Copy the 21 entire link. So which link should I copy? This 2.2 one? 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is there a 24 form? 25 MS. BOGALE: Is it the Social Security

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1 Declaration Form? 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is the top 3 on the form, ma'am? 4 MS. BOGALE: Am I copying the form 5 from the chat box? What is CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. 6 7 the form? What does that form state? 8 MS. BOGALE: No, I haven't opened it 9 yet. Let me copy it. Social Security Declaration Form. 10 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, ma'am. MS. BOGALE: 12 Okay. Copy link. 13 There's nothing I can open. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on. 15 MS. BOGALE: Okay. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you able to 17 copy the instructions? 18 MR. ORELLANA: The link is broken in 19 the chat, but you want to copy from HTTPS: all 20 the way to .pdf. Part of it is hyperlink so you 21 want to copy that entire thing. 2.2 MS. BOGALE: Okay. And past it on the 23 Right? web. 24 MR. ORELLANA: Yes. 25 MS. BOGALE: Okay. Yeah. I'm looking

1 at it right now. It says Social Security 2 Declaration Form. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you able to 4 complete the form and turn it into the Agency by 5 Friday? Yes, we are. We can send 6 MS. BOGALE: it today, by the end of the day. 7 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, 9 It's my understanding that this is the ma'am. only document that is required so, therefore, it 10 11 you send this document in by Friday, the Agency 12 will move forward with the issuance of your 13 license. 14 MS. BOGALE: Okay. Thank you. So which email should be forwarded this to? 15 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who have you been sending documents to? 17 18 MS. BOGALE: Ms. Rubio. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who is Ms. 20 Rubio? Is that the --21 MS. BOGALE: Ms. Jocelyn Rubio. Her 2.2 first name is Jocelyn. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Send 2.4 that email to her, ma'am. 25 MS. BOGALE: Okay. Will do. Thank

1 you so much. 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now, let me ask 3 you a question. How long have you been in 4 business? MS. BOGALE: For the unlicensed it's 5 6 been a year and like maybe seven months. 7 Something like that, yeah. Almost two years. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is it that 9 you sell? I'm sorry? 10 MS. BOGALE: Almost two years. Sorry. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is it 12 that you sell? 13 MS. BOGALE: So we have tobacco 14 products. We are only gifting. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, part of 16 this is that you need to establish that you are 17 actually in business. All right. So what is it 18 that you were -- I know this is a little bit kind 19 of tricky, but you were asked to prove that you 20 are actually in business. 21 MS. BOGALE: Yes. 2.2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But I just want 23 you to tell us what gifting, ma'am? MS. BOGALE: We are gifting marijuana. 2.4 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And for how

1 long, ma'am? 2 MS. BOGALE: Well, almost like two, 3 two-and-a-half years. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 4 5 That's fine. I'm not trying to trick you, okay? This is not a trick. One of the questions the 6 7 Agency had asked you is that you had to prove 8 that you are actually in business for a period of 9 time gifting. All right? I've seen some of the pictures that you had submitted so I assume -- I 10 11 was just asking to clarify that. 12 Any Board Members have any questions 13 of this potential licensee? 14 All right. Since the Board Members 15 don't have any questions of this licensee, ma'am, 16 send that form in as quickly as possible. 17 MS. BOGALE: Okay. We will. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I believe the 19 last document -- I was informed by the Agency 20 that this is the last document that is required 21 for your -- for the business for us to process 2.2 the license. 23 I believe the next step, if the license -- if the license is processed by our 24 25 agency, the next step is that it needs to be

placarded for the neighborhood to know that you have applied for a license. MS. BOGALE: Okay.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: One thing that 4 5 I would recommend, ma'am, for you to come in -for you guys to come into the office and have the 6 7 Agency explain the process moving forward because 8 I think what I hear that you're saying is that 9 you were not aware what was missing, or you were 10 not aware that your application was denied, but 11 it was clear to you what is it that we were 12 seeking from you.

I'm just concerned that even at this hearing you're telling me that you were not aware of -- you were not aware that this was the last piece of -- okay. Hold on, hold on, hold on. I'm sorry.

MS. BOGALE: No problem.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on a 20 minute, please. Just don't -- I want to -- hold 21 on a minute. Hold on, hold on.

MS. BOGALE: Okay.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on, hold
on. Don't go anywhere. Okay? Just hold on one
minute, please. Okay? All right.

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1	As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
2	Beverage and Cannabis Board for the District of
3	Columbia and in accordance with D.C I'm going
4	to go into Executive Session. Okay? I just want
5	to advise the rest of the Board Members.
6	As Chairperson of the Alcoholic
7	Beverage and Cannabis Board for the District of
8	Columbia and in accordance with D.C. Official
9	Code Section 2575 of the Open Meetings Act, I
10	move that the ABC Board hold a closed meeting for
11	the purpose of seeking legal advice from our
12	counsel on One Spot Tobacco Shop for the reasons
13	cited in D.C. Official Code for the reasons
14	pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section
15	2575(b)(4)(a) of the Open Meetings Act.
16	Is there a second?
17	MEMBER GRANT: Second.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
19	seconded the motion. We'll take a roll call
20	vote.
21	Mr. Short.
22	MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?
24	MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant. I agree.
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,

1 The matter passes 3-0. I agree. 2 We're going to log off but stay on the I'm asking all Board Members to move to 3 line. executive session. You stay right there. 4 We'll 5 be back. Okay? All right. Thank. (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter went 6 7 off the record at 1:55 p.m. and resumed at 2:05 8 p.m.) 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The ABC Board is back on the record. There is a 10 11 legal question that the Board has so we had to go into executive session so our legal counsel could 12 13 provide us some legal advice. I want to correct the record. 14 The 15 form that was in the link, forget about that 16 form. That was not related to you. We have two establishments with two very similar names. 17 Ι 18 got both establishments confused. The form that 19 I shared with you before, I need you to just 20 basically forget about that form. It's not 21 required for you. 2.2 MS. BOGALE: I have it in my hand. We 23 found it. We already submit that. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 24 Right. I'm 25 aware of that. All right. What I want -- I have

a couple of questions. Who is the owner? 1 2 MS. BOGALE: He is the owner. 3 MR. ALIGAZ: I'm the owner. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 4 I'm 5 going to ask you some questions. Can you raise 6 your right hand, please? 7 MR. ALIGAZ: Sure. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I need you to 9 swear or affirm that you will tell the truth and nothing but the truth? 10 11 MR. ALIGAZ: The truth. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay, sir. 13 When did -- you can put your hand down, sir. You 14 can put your hand down. How long have you owned 15 this business? 16 MR. ALIGAZ: The tobacco shop I own it 17 2020, almost four years now. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: When in 2020? 19 MR. ALIGAZ: To be honest, I don't 20 remember exact date but --21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But in 2020. 2.2 About what month? Do you remember? 23 MR. ALIGAZ: Like after two months, 24 three months. I should have it on the paper. 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm just asking

1 if you can tell me. 2 MR. ALIGAZ: Yes. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you're saying you've owned the tobacco shop since 2020. 4 5 MR. ALIGAZ: 2020. 6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. And 7 so -- go ahead, sir. 8 MR. ALIGAZ: And then I started an I-9 71 up to two years. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: When did you 11 start gifting? MR. ALIGAZ: When did I? 12 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. MR. ALIGAZ: Almost two and a half and 14 15 some change. Two-and-a-half years. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What year and 17 what month did you start to gift, sir? 18 MR. ALIGAZ: It was around, I would 19 say, 2022, the end of it. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I need --20 21 MR. ALIGAZ: The end of 2021. 2.2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on, sir. 23 I need you to be very -- I need you to be very specific. Approximately when is it that you 24 25 started to gift products?

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1	MR. ALIGAZ: The end of 2021. I would
2	say the date was maybe around June.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So why did you
4	believe I mean, why did you decide in June of
5	2021 to start gifting products?
6	MR. ALIGAZ: It's been a there's
7	people that was doing it. Then I had the tobacco
8	shop so I just decide to do it after people
9	started doing it. That was the reason.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So
11	MR. ALIGAZ: A friend of mine was
12	telling me he would give me the information about
13	the gifting license, all that good stuff, so I
14	just start doing that because I had a cell phone
15	store. When I got to this building I switch it
16	to tobacco shop.
17	After that a friend of mine give me
18	the info and then I just started doing the
19	gifting. The community come so the community
20	always come. I take care of them. Every time I
21	give them gift and I give them the bong.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So how does the
23	community know that you were gifting, that you
24	are in the gifting business?
25	MR. ALIGAZ: We have the sign out. We

have a poster that says I-71 compliance so there's a sign outside, too. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What about MR. ALIGAZ: People walking a lot. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. What about was there anything on like social media around that time? I mean MR. ALIGAZ: We didn't put it that much out, but on the website there's a complimen that the customer give me about the product and stuff. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so like h far back like when do you have a complimen from 2021 that a customer provided to you, or 2022?				
3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What about 4 MR. ALIGAZ: People walking a lot. 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. What 6 about was there anything on like social media 7 around that time? I mean 8 MR. ALIGAZ: We didn't put it that 9 much out, but on the website there's a compliment 10 that the customer give me about the product and 11 stuff. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so like ht 13 far back like when do you have a compliment 14 from 2021 that a customer provided to you, or				
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15 2022?				
16 MR. ALIGAZ: To be honest, I didn't				
17 really check my website, but I have regular				
18 people that comes in the community and they come				
19 and shop. Since I started doing the form, I				
20 already told them to write me anything, you know	•			
21 MR. JONES: Tell him you submitted				
22 documentation.				
23 MR. ALIGAZ: Yeah. I submitted a				
document, too, yeah, yeah, for the customer. I				
25 submit it. I give it to Sean. I already send i	t			

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ahead, ma'am.

submitted was from the customers like a review that they have been like coming here and then like, you know, doing the gifting for the past
like, you know, doing the gifting for the past
two-and-a-half years or something like that. We
submitted that with the appeal letter.
Also, I don't know, but like we have
been wanting this license because we know like we
want to be legal. Also like we were doing the
initiative because we applied on December and we
didn't hear anything back. Then we tried to
contact them on February. Nothing back and we
walked in the office on March.
From December to March we didn't hear
anything. We had to go to the office to get the
denial letter because we never received the
denial letter. Then we appealed after that. I
mean, we have been like trying our best, you
know, like to get this and then, yeah.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Just one so
when you started, what type of products were you
gifting?
MS. BOGALE: The gifting?
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What products

were you gifting?

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2 MS. BOGALE: So the marijuana. We had 3 the marijuana, the THC cards, and we also have the gummies. And then like we provide them with 4 5 bongs, torch lighters, and everything. You know, Then we do the gifting like 6 what they want. 7 Also, if you want us to share. I don't that. 8 know if we can do that on this screen but --9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What do you 10 want to do? 11 MS. BOGALE: We can show you our 12 showcase that we have. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Your who? 14 MS. BOGALE: Showcase. We are at the 15 store right now so we can show you our showcase 16 that we show the customers. 17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, that's not 18 necessary. It's a different question. I don't 19 think there is any question that you are doing --Yes, Mr. Short. Go ahead. 20 You have 21 a question you want to ask, sir? 2.2 MEMBER SHORT: What form did you 23 You keep mentioning Mr. Sean Gordy. submit? 24 What did you submit to Mr. Gordy? 25 MS. BOGALE: So we submitted out

1 customers' reviews. Then also we submitted the 2 pictures, the store pictures, the inside and out. Everything with the D.C. I-71 compliance poster 3 4 and outside posters and everything, yeah. 5 MEMBER SHORT: Prior to them giving you a denial letter? 6 7 MS. BOGALE: Yes, yes. We had to call 8 to get a status because we had never heard 9 anything. We called the office and they gave us Mr. Sean's phone number. When we called him, he 10 11 told us to send him the proof that we are doing 12 the unlicensed. 13 That's what the document required. 14 After we sent it, after like two weeks or 15 something we emailed him. I think he didn't get or he didn't receive our email. We called him 16 and he said like the ABCA is doing a meeting on 17 18 every Wednesday so we have to wait. 19 Since we didn't hear anything back 20 from him, we went to the office just to get a 21 status because -- yeah, we found him at the 2.2 office and he took us to Ms. Rubio telling us 23 that she is the one handling our application. She said I think it's the proof that you need to 24 25 submit so just send it to me.

1 We send it to her that day, the same 2 The next day we called her and then she day. 3 said she's going to send us an official denial 4 letter which we didn't receive before. After 5 that we sent the appeal. You met with two people 6 MEMBER SHORT: 7 in our office, Sean Gordy and Ms. Rubio? 8 MS. BOGALE: Rubio, yes. 9 MEMBER SHORT: Those are the only two 10 that you dealt with? 11 MS. BOGALE: Yes. 12 MEMBER SHORT: And you gave them all 13 of your documents that they requested? 14 MS. BOGALE: Yes, yes. We gave them 15 two times. 16 MEMBER SHORT: And they never 17 responded to you? 18 MS. BOGALE: No. Mr. Sean didn't 19 respond to us until we went to his office to like 20 refer us to Ms. Rubio. After we found Ms. Rubio, 21 she was replying us because like we asked her what we can do, what we can send as a proof. 2.2 23 Then she told us she's going to send us an official denial letter. She sent us the denial 24 25 letter. That's when we appealed.

1	MR. ALIGAZ: And we called him several
2	times and leave him a voicemail two three times.
3	After he never called we walked to the office.
4	MR. JONES: Excuse me, gentlemen. My
5	name is Jimmie Jones.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry. Who
7	are you, sir?
8	MR. JONES: Jimmie Jones. I am I
9	have been doing processing for applications and
10	permitting in D.C. for about 40 years. These are
11	friends of mine. I joined them today because I
12	looked through everything and talked to them and
13	I saw that I thought I might be able to point out
14	there was, I felt, a language barrier in terms of
15	clarity and responding.
16	What I want to say now, or to add, and
17	I don't mind being sworn in. I've been going to
18	DCRA since 1972. My point to you is that they
19	submitted back in around December 15th. They
20	waited and became they had no response to
21	anything.
22	They began the outreach to find out
23	what was missing, what was going on, what was the
24	status. They submitted everything and still no
25	feedback. They even visited the office. There

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1 was a problem in terms of -- I cannot say but 2 maybe some paperwork got lost. The point is they 3 submitted everything. You're exactly where you want to be, 4 5 Ethiopia and Anania. You have explained. I only wanted to clarify what they are saying is that 6 7 they waited but received no response. They visited the office and got no response. 8 9 In terms of what any missing document was, they did not hear that until the denial 10 11 process happened. That is why I joined them, 12 just to be able to say that if I felt they 13 weren't fully explaining. That's all. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 15 MR. JONES: I reviewed the paperwork 16 and even -- anyway, that's it. I'll be quiet 17 I'm not sworn in but I have no problem in now. 18 terms of trying to help them. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. That's fine. 20 21 MR. JONES: Okay. 2.2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, sir. All right. We'll take this matter 23 under advisement and we will -- I believe the 24 25 only missing document -- I think what was missing

1	is proof that you were in business prior to
2	December 31, 2022. I've seen that you have
3	MR. ALIGAZ: You have the C of O.
4	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I see that you
5	have submitted a letter to the Agency. I've seen
6	two letters to say that you were in business and
7	you have testified under oath that you were in
8	business prior to December 31, 2022.
9	This is the final this is what's
