CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're now at the end of our morning calendar, so let us now do our agendas. Let's do our Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Legal Agenda is a review of an Offer-in-Compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated April 27, 2022, for Case No. 22251-00003, The Fireplace, License No. 014419.

The Offer-in-Compromise, Charge 1, allows the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose, statutory authority, DC Code, Section 25, 82382. That charge will be dismissed.

Charge 2, fail to follow security plans, statutory authority, DC Code, Section 82386. There's a fine of $\$ 1,000$, payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the Offer-in-Compromise.

If payment is not made with 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment has been made.

I make a motion that we approve the Offer-in-Compromise. Is there a second?

MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett seconds.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Crockett has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen? MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis? MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And, Mr. Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 6-0-0.

Number 2, review of an Offer-inCompromise in lieu of a hearing, dated May 4, 2022, for Case No. 21-CMP-00007, MK Lounge \& Restaurant, License No. 88787.

The Offer-in-Compromise is as follows:
Charge 1, failure to comply with the Mayor's order. Patrons were not wearing masks, failed to
provide social distancing by allowing more than six individuals to be seated at a table, failing to comply with 25 percent occupancy, 23 D.C.M.R., Section 810.2.

And the offer is \$2,000, payable within 120 days, or the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 2, failure to comply with the Mayor's order. Failure to provide social distancing by allowing more than six individuals to be seated at a table, 23 D.C.M.R., Section 810.2. That has been dismissed.

And Charge 3, failure to comply with the Mayor's order. Failure to comply with 25 percent occupancy. 23 D.C.M.R., Section 810.3. This charge has also been dismissed.

I, therefore, make a motion that the Offer-in-Compromise be accepted. That is, that Charge 1, $\$ 2,000$ within 120 days or the license shall be suspended until the fine has been paid, and the other two charges have been dismissed. Is there a second?

MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will
second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis has seconded the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.

I make a motion that we approve this request. Is there a second?
