CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're now at the end of our morning calendar, so let us now do our agendas. Let's do our Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Legal Agenda is a review of an Offer-in-Compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated April 27, 2022, for Case No. 22251-00003, The Fireplace, License No. 014419.

The Offer-in-Compromise, Charge 1, allows the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose, statutory authority, DC Code, Section 25, 82382. That charge will be dismissed.

Charge 2, fail to follow security plans, statutory authority, DC Code, Section 82386. There's a fine of \$1,000, payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the Offerin-Compromise.

If payment is not made with 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment has been made.

I make a motion that we approve the Offer-in-Compromise. Is there a second?

19	Number 2, review of an Offer-in-
20	Compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated May 4,
21	2022, for Case No. 21-CMP-00007, MK Lounge &
22	Restaurant, License No. 88787.
23	The Offer-in-Compromise is as follows:
24	Charge 1, failure to comply with the Mayor's
25	order. Patrons were not wearing masks, failed to

provide social distancing by allowing more than 1 six individuals to be seated at a table, failing 2 3 to comply with 25 percent occupancy, 23 D.C.M.R., Section 810.2. 4 And the offer is \$2,000, payable 5 within 120 days, or the license will be suspended 6 7 indefinitely until the fine has been paid. Charge 2, failure to comply with the 8 9 Mayor's order. Failure to provide social distancing by allowing more than six individuals 10 11 to be seated at a table, 23 D.C.M.R., 12 Section 810.2. That has been dismissed. 13 And Charge 3, failure to comply with 14 the Mayor's order. Failure to comply with 15 25 percent occupancy. 23 D.C.M.R., 16 Section 810.3. This charge has also been 17 dismissed. 18 I, therefore, make a motion that the 19 Offer-in-Compromise be accepted. That is, that 20 Charge 1, \$2,000 within 120 days or the license 21 shall be suspended until the fine has been paid, 22 and the other two charges have been dismissed. 23 Is there a second? 24 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will

17	load of 2,000. Is there a second?
