CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So therefore, on June 8th, you can have whatever documents or witnesses that you -- you're going to defend yourself.

And seven days before the hearing, sir, each side is required to submit documents and witnesses that they're going to rely on at the hearing.

Those documents must -- must be disclosed to each side, to the office -- to the Attorney General's Office, and also, to ABRA Legal.

And -- and if -- if the parties fail to disclose the documents, unless good cause is shown, the ABC Board might prevent the part -- the side from relying on documents and witnesses that have not disclosed seven days prior to the

1	hearing. Do you understand, sir?
