licensee respondent submits this offer in

compromise to the Alcoholic Beverage Control

Board as authorized by 23 DCMR Section 1611.5 for approval by the Board. The parties understand that if the Board approves the OIC appeal and traditional review are waived under 23 DCMR Section 1611.6, scheduled hearings will be vacated, and the case will conclude. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the OIC terms shown below.

If the Board doesn't approve the OIC, the matter will be continued to a show cause hearing for May 5, 2021, at 1:30 p.m.

The respondent has been advised that there is no obligation towards OIC. Respondent has been advised through service of notice of status hearing and show cause hearing that at a show cause hearing, the respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, crossexamine witnesses, and apply to the Board for a qualified interpreter.

The OIC terms are as follows. The term -- charge 1, failure to follow a Board order by allowing the sales, service, or consumption of alcohol on the premises while the establishment's

license was suspended. Statutory authority, DC Code Section 25-823(a)(6). Term 1, there is no fine; term 2, no suspension; term 3, other term, the licensee agrees to surrender the license for safekeeping following the Board's approval of this OIC. Respondent shall immediately cease all service and sale of alcohol and ensure that all alcoholic beverages are secure and not accessible to the public for sale, service, or consumption. Respondent shall surrender the license for safekeeping and all alcohol will be removed from respondent's premises by 12:00 p.m. on May 7, 2021. Respondent shall file an application for the transfer of respondent's ABC license within 30 days of the Board's order accepting this OIC. Respondent's owners, including David Roundtree, will have no ownership interest in the new license holder, who shall be a bona fide purchaser.

If a transfer application cannot be filed in 30 days, then within the same period, Respondent must file a report with the Board detailing efforts to secure a purchaser or the license shall be canceled. Respondent may not withdraw a transfer application if the Board

disapproves the transfer, but may file a new transfer application within 30 days of disapproval. If the license is not transferred to a new owner by November 3, 2021, the license shall be deemed canceled by the Board, providing that any request for an extension for reasonable cause may be to the Board and granted or denied at its discretion.

Charge 2, interference with an investigator, investigation; statutory authority DC Code Section 25-823(a)(5). The other terms are the terms that were just read in the record for charge 3 -- for the first charge.

23	Now this is a global settlement, so
24	I'm going to review the terms of the OIC for all
25	the cases. And once I review all the OICs, then

I will make a motion to the Board whether or not the Board should accept or reject the OICs. So I just want to remind the Board this is one OIC that's been presented, although it covers several cases. Okay.

So the first case is Case No. 19-AUD-00119. The charge for this case is fail to file the required quarterly statement, DC Official Code Section 25-113(b)(2)(a), and this was for the third quarter of 2019 for the period July through September 2019. This is the seventh second tier violation with four years. The OIC terms are \$2,000 paid within 120 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the The licensee will submit pending fine is paid. quarterly statements if they have not been submitted and that the respondent shall attend the Agency's books and records training for hotels and restaurants within 30 days. That's the first case.

The Case Number CMP-00017, charge 1, provide live entertainment without the endorsement; DC Official Code Section 25-113(a)(b)(1). This is a primary tier violation. Offense is the third primary tier violation

within three years. The terms of the OIC is a warning and that the respondent shall apply for an entertainment endorsement within 30 days.

The next case on -- that's covered in this OIC is Case Number 20-251-00036. Charge 1 in this case is allowing the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose; DC Official Code Section 25-823(a)(2). It's the third primary tier violation within three years. The OIC terms are as follows. A \$6,000 fine payable within 120 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid and that there is a 20-day suspension to be served. The 20-day suspension will be served from July 21st through August 12th, 2021. The dates are excluded from the terms of the suspension are July 26, August 2nd, and August 9th, 2021. the reason why these dates are excluded is because the licensee is not open on Mondays so, therefore, because it's closed on a Monday, these days do not count in the 20-day mandatory suspension.

Charge 2, failed to follow the terms of the approved license by operating on a Monday. This is DC Official Code Section 25-823(a)(7).

The OIC term is a warning.

Case Number 19-CMP-00207, charge 1, failed to keep and maintain books and records for three years; DC Code Section 25-113(j)(3) and 23 DCMR Section 1204. The OIC terms for this one is a warning.

And the next case is Case Number 20-CIT-00201. Charge 1, failed to comply with Mayor's Order and Board's emergency rulemaking pursuant to Section 23 DCMR Section 810. The offense, third primary tier violation within three years. The OIC terms is \$1,000 payable within 120 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. And so for this global OIC, there is a total fine of \$9,000 with a 20-day suspension to be served July 21st through August 12th, 2021.
