3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is 600 T. This is Case No. 23-PRO-
5 00042, Stephen Lawrence trading as 600 T, 600 T
6 Street, NW, License No. ABRA-100515. This is a
7 Retailer Class CT license renewal. The protest
8 issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and
9 quiet. My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
10 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.

11 Is anyone present on behalf of 600 T?

12 MR. LAWRENCE: I am. My name is
13 Stephen Lawrence, S-T-E-P-H-E-N L-A-W-R-E-N-C-E.
14 I'm the owner of 600 T.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Lawrence, does your
16 telephone number end in 82?

17 MR. LAWRENCE: Yes, ma'am.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

19 MR. LAWRENCE: Is the Protestant
20 present?

21 MR. KUJAWA: Yes. Good morning again,
22 Ms. Fletcher. My name is Craig Kujawa. It's
23 spelled C-R-A-I-G. The last name is K-U-J-A-W-A.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Kujawa.
25 You filed your protest as an abutting property

1 owner. It appears that the properties do abut.
2 Therefore, you are granted standing as a
3 protestant.

4 We need to set a date for -- let me
5 also look for the record, Mr. Kujawa. You know
6 this already but your protest was actually
7 grandfathered in before today.

8 You are present and you are granted
9 standing. If for some reason you were not able
10 to be present, you still would have been granted
11 standing because your previous protest was
12 grandfathered in. Just saying that for the
13 record.

14 We need to set a date for a status
15 hearing, a protest hearing, and a mediation.
16 I'll give you the date for the status and protest
17 hearing first. The status hearing is set for
18 June 28, 2023, at 10:30 a.m. for the status
19 hearing.

20 The protesting hearing is set for July
21 26 at 1:30. I will give you the next available
22 date for mediation. The next available day is
23 Tuesday, June 6, anytime between 10:30 and 1:30
24 in the afternoon. That's June 6th on a Tuesday
25 anytime between 10:30 and 1:30 if that day works.

1 MR. KUJAWA: That works for me.

2 MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry? You said
3 that you are available, Mr. Kujawa?

4 MR. KUJAWA: Yeah, anytime in that
5 window on the 6th is fine for me.

6 MS. FLETCHER: What about you, Mr.
7 Lawrence?

8 MR. LAWRENCE: Me as well. That
9 works.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Well, then let's make
11 it 11:00 on Tuesday, June 6. I will send you the
12 WebEx invitation to attend. Any questions at
13 all?

14 MR. LAWRENCE: No, ma'am.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

16 MR. KUJAWA: No, ma'am.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.

18 The roll call hearing in this matter is
19 concluded. See you on June 6th. Thank you.
