CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.

As chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage and

Cannabis Board for the District of Columbia and
in accordance with D.C. Code Section 2571 et.

seq. of the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I am

the Alcoholic Beverage Cannabis Board. This

My name is Donovan Anderson; I'm 1 chairperson of the board. I would like to 2 3 introduce other members of the ABC Board who are 4 also participating electronically. Please 5 respond when I announce your name. Mr. James Short? 6 7 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. James Short, 8 present. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bobby Cato? 10 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, present. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Jeni 12 Hansen? Mr. Edward Grandis? 13 14 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, 15 present. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The board has 17 five members in attendance for the conduct of 18 business today and that constitutes a quorum. 19 Before we get on with today's hearing calendar I need to make a few instructions very 20 21 clear so that the conduct of these hearings is 22 (Inaudible). 23 There are five cases scheduled for 24 this morning's calendar. Once a case is called I 25 will take a moment for IT specialist to elevate

17	please elevate the rights of the licensee and the
18	protestor in this case, please?
19	MR. ORELLANA: Andrew Kline, your
20	access has been elevated.
21	I do not see anyone else in
22	attendance.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
24	Good morning, thank you.

Good morning, Mr. Kline. Can you

please identify yourself for the record, please? 1 2 MR. KLINE: Good morning, Chairman 3 Anderson and members of the board. Andrew Kline, A-N-D-R-E-W, last name is spelled Kline, K-L-I-N-4 5 E. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 6 7 Good morning, sir. I see that the protestant is 8 not here this morning. Is there any 9 representation or preliminary matters you can 10 report back to the board? 11 MR. KLINE: Yes, we had mediation 12 scheduled for this past Monday and Bradley Thomas 13 who appeared on behalf of the protestant 14 indicated that the protest was gonna be 15 withdrawn. We haven't seen any paperwork to that 16 effect, but that was the expressed intention at 17 that point. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, this matter was scheduled. 19 20 Mr. Orellana, do me one favor again, 21 please. 22 MR. KLINE: Oh, Mr. Thomas. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Thomas, can 24 you please identify yourself for the record, 25 please, by spelling and stating your name?

MR. THOMAS: Yeah, this is Bradley
Thomas on behalf of the Bates Area Civic
Association.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, sir. Now, are there any preliminary matters you want to bring to the attention of the board, sir?

MR. THOMAS: Yeah, I think I heard Mr. Kline, he's correct; the Board of the Civic Association has decided to recommend to the association that the protest be dismissed. But I can't officially dismiss it today because the body has to meet on the first Monday in June and this will be on the agenda. But I have no reason, as I indicated on Monday at the meeting, I have no reason to believe that the body will not accept the recommendation of the board and vote to dismiss the protest.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so well when -- since you're not in a position to do that today, so I'll just say that this matter has been scheduled for protest hearing on July 19th, 2023 at 1:30 p.m. And I'll ask you if this matter is gonna be dismissed that you inform the agency as soon as possible so we do not have to assign an investigator to this case, okay?
