CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. We've now closed off our morning calendar. And with that said, let's now move to our agenda items for the morning.

Our first agenda item is our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal agenda is a Review of Offer in Compromise in Lieu of Hearing dated May 23, 2023, the case number 22-CMP-00093, Bravo Bravo, License Number 071564. The offer in compromise is as follows.

Charge 1 violated the terms of the establishment security plan, it's a primary chair violation. Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25823A6. There is a fine of $\$ 1,000$ paid within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Is there a second?

Charge 1, operating and offer entertainment outside of approved hours. The statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25762A and B13. There is a fine of $\$ 1,000$ paid within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 2, operating over occupancy. Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25762B1. There's a $\$ 1,000$ fine paid within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge number 3. Failed to ensure camera was operational. Statutory authority D.C.

Code Section 25836G1. There is a \$1,000 fine paid within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

And other terms, the Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration enforcement shall be permitted to conduct a walkthrough of the establishment to ensure cameras are operational.
