3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

4 We've now closed off our morning calendar. And
5 with that said, let's now move to our agenda
6 items for the morning.

7 Our first agenda item is our legal
8 agenda. The first matter on our legal agenda is
9 a Review of Offer in Compromise in Lieu of
10 Hearing dated May 23, 2023, the case number
11 22-CMP-00093, Bravo Bravo, License Number 071564.
12 The offer in compromise is as follows.

13 Charge 1 violated the terms of the
14 establishment security plan, it's a primary chair
15 violation. Statutory authority, D.C. Code
16 Section 25823A6. There is a fine of \$1,000 paid
17 within 30 days or the license shall be suspended
18 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

19 Is there a second?

20 MEMBER CATO: Cato seconds.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato
22 seconded the motion, we'll now have a roll call
23 vote. Mr. Short?

24 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Cato?

1 MEMBER CATO: Cato, I agree.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

3 MEMBER HANSEN: Yes, and I agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

5 MEMBER GRANDIS: Agree.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

7 Anderson, I agree. The matter passes 5-0-0.

8 Number two. Review of an Offer in
9 Compromise in Lieu of a Hearing dated May 23,
10 2023. This is for Case Number 23-CMP-00032,
11 Boulevard Lounge, License Number 115385. The
12 offer in compromise is as follows.

13 Charge 1, operating and offer
14 entertainment outside of approved hours. The
15 statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25762A and
16 B13. There is a fine of \$1,000 paid within 30
17 days or the license shall be suspended
18 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

19 Charge 2, operating over occupancy.
20 Statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25762B1.
21 There's a \$1,000 fine paid within 30 days or the
22 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
23 fine has been paid.

24 Charge number 3. Failed to ensure
25 camera was operational. Statutory authority D.C.

1 Code Section 25836G1. There is a \$1,000 fine
2 paid within 30 days or the license shall be
3 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
4 paid.

5 And other terms, the Alcoholic
6 Beverage and Cannabis Administration enforcement
7 shall be permitted to conduct a walkthrough of
8 the establishment to ensure cameras are
9 operational.

10 I therefore make a motion that this
11 matter -- I'm sorry, I make a motion that we
12 approve this offer in compromise. Is there a
13 second?

14 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

15 MEMBER GRANDIS: Mr. Grandis.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short and
17 Mr. Grandis have seconded the motion. We'll now

3 Number three. Review of an Offer in
4 Compromise in Lieu of a Hearing dated May 23,
5 2023 for Case Number 22-CMP-00090, Johnny
6 Pistolas, License Number 060401.

7 The offer in compromise for this case
8 is Charge 1, exceeded the establishment's
9 approved occupancy limit, statutory authority,
10 D.C. Code Section 25762B1. There's a \$1,000
11 term, that's \$1,000 paid within 30 days or the
12 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
13 fine has been paid.

14 Charge 2. Violated the
15 establishment's settlement agreement, statutory
16 authority D.C. Code Section 2582386. And the
17 other matter was dismissed -- I'm sorry, D.C.
18 Code Section for Charge 2, that matter was
19 dismissed.

20 Charge 3, made substantial changes in
21 operation without obtaining board approval.
22 Statutory authority 25762B4. That charge, that
23 other term has been dismissed.

24 So, but I therefore make a motion that
25 the offer in compromise be accepted. Is there a

1 second?

2 MEMBER CATO: Second. Bobby Cato
