Additional term, the license shall be suspended for five days. All five days will be stayed for one year.

And all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licenses establishment completes an alcohol training program within three months from the OIC's date.

Charge Number Two, failure to take reasonable steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25783. The fine, a warning will be issued in this case.
