18 First name is C-H-R-I-S, last name Southcott S-O-
19 U-T-H-C-O-T-T.

20 I am an attorney from the Office of
21 the Attorney General who is handling the show
22 cause status hearing in this case.

23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
24 again, sir. I see that the Licensee is not here.
25 Again, this is a show cause hearing status, the

1 Licensee is not required to be here.

2 This matter then is scheduled for a
3 show cause hearing on June 29, 2022 at 1:30 p.m.
4 And although the Licensee is not here, they will
5 have -- they'll have an opportunity to get a copy
6 of the transcript.

7 But, I just want to remind all parties
8 that when this matter goes to a show cause
9 hearing, seven days prior to the hearing, the
10 parties are required to disclose documents and
11 witnesses that will be relied upon at the
12 hearing.
