This Third Emergency Rulemaking, the purpose of this rulemaking is to, one, restore the hours of eligibility for obtaining reimbursement for RDO services to the pre-COVID-19 pandemic hours of 11:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Sunday through Saturday.

Number two, to restoring the hours of eligibility for obtaining reimbursement for RDO services for temporary license holder or those approved for a one-day suspension to each license to the pre-COVID-19 pandemic hours of 24 hours a day.

And Number three is to add in the DC Main Street's program to the list of entities eligible for participation in the RDO subsidy program.
