MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is Capitol View Market, this is Case Number 24-PRO-00044, I'm not sure how to pronounce, F-I-K-R-E Market, Inc., 4920 Central Avenue, Northeast, License Number ABRA 076250.

This is a Retailer Class A liquor store for a license renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, and residential parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

25	give you the dates for the status and protest

4	set for July 24, at 1:30.
5	We need to set a date for mediation.
