The offer in compromise is charge 1, failed to provide prepared food with sales, service, and consumption of alcohol. This is a first primary tier violation, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-113(I)(2) and 23 DCRM Section 2000.1. The fine is $\$ 1,000$ payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 2, failed to produce requested records within 48 hours. This is a first primary tier violation, statutory authority D.C. Code

Section 25-113(I)(4) and Section 25-823(A)(5). There is a $\$ 1,000$ fine payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge 3, no ODA or ABC manager, first secondary tier violation, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-701. There is a fine of \$250 payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely.
