3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, I
4 guess you're here. The next case on our calendar
5 is we have a show cause hearing status, Case
6 Number 22-251-00023, Brooklyn. Mr. Orellana, can
7 you please elevate the rights of the licensee and
8 the government in this case, please?

9 MR. ORELLANA: Sure. Bisola Oni, your

3 send an offer in compromise to Mr. Mixon and we
4 haven't got a response yet.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
6 thank you. All right, this matter is scheduled
7 for a show cause hearing on July 12, 2023 at
8 10:30 a.m. If this matter goes to a show cause
9 hearing, both parties are required seven days
10 prior to the hearing to disclose documents and
11 witnesses to each other, and also to the agency.

12 Failure by either side to disclose
13 documents or witnesses seven days prior to the
14 hearing that will be relied on at the hearing,
15 the board is empowered to prevent that side from
16 moving forward. Are there any questions?

17 MR. MIXON: Can you please repeat the
18 date of the show cause hearing?
