3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The next
4 case in our calendar is Case Number 23-PRO-00045,
5 ZOOZ, Z-O-O-Z, License Number 124023.

6 Mr. Orellana, can you please again elevate
7 the rights of the licensee and the protestant in this
8 case, please?

9 MR. MIXON: Hello. Cameron Mixon. Also --

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on, Mr. Mixon,
11 hold on. We need to elevate the protestant.

12 MR. ORELLANA: Oh, well, I think that's what
13 he's going to clear up. The protestant --

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Mr. Mixon, go
15 ahead, sir.

16 MR. MIXON: Hi, also Cameron Mixon, also
17 counsel to the licensee in this case, ZOOZ. We are in
18 the midst of the settlement process and are awaiting
19 final confirmation from the protestants.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And did the
21 protestant ask you to fill in for them today, sir, or
22 why are they not here today?

23 MR. MIXON: I'm not aware of the
24 protestants' decision with respect to today. I
25 imagine that they would be here, but I had last spoken

1 to them yesterday.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, who's the
3 protestant in this case, sir? And Mr. Mixon, if you
4 have a camera, I'd prefer when I'm speaking to folks
5 that they, if they have a camera, they turn their
6 camera on, sir.

7 Bob Link, okay. All right. So if you have
8 a camera, Mr. Mixon, I would appreciate if you can
9 turn your camera on?

10 MR. MIXON: Yes, sir. To answer your
11 question, it's ANC6D, which, yes, Bob Link I believe
12 is commissioner.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I see
14 that in the chat that we have asked for the protestant
15 to identify themselves, and if the protestant fails to
16 identify themselves then I need to dismiss the
17 protestant unless they - yes, good morning, sir.
18 Good to see you.

19 I'm not familiar with you, sir, so, and it
20 has always been my position that I ask all -- I ask
21 everyone who participates in front of me, unless there
22 is some reason, that you appear on camera, sir. All
23 right?

24 MR. MIXON: Understood.

25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. All

1 right, so let's ask, is the protestant from ANC6D
2 online?

3 (No response.)

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No one has
5 identified themselves as representing the protestants'
6 group. This matter was scheduled for a protestant
7 hearing status at 10:30 this morning. It is 10:58.
8 I've called the case and the protestant is not here,
9 there I'm going to make a motion that the protest be
10 dismissed. Is there a second?

11 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
13 seconded the motion. I'll have a roll call vote. Mr.
14 Short?

15 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

17 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

19 MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis?

21 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson, I
23 agree. The matter passes 5-0-0.

24 What this means, sir, is that the protestant
25 will issue a board -- a board order dismissing the

1 protestant. The protestant will be given ten days to
2 provide the board reasonable notice why they failed to
3 appear here today.

4 Failure on the part of the protestant to
5 give reasonable notice to the board -- is Chander
6 Jayaraman, is he the protestant in this case? I
7 believe he's from ANC6.

8 Mr. -- no? All right, then you're not the
9 protestant in this case. Okay, so failure by the
10 protestant to give reasonable notice to the Board why
11 they failed to appear here today. We'll dismiss this
12 matter. And the Board will direct the agency to move
13 forward with issuing of the license, okay? All right,
14 so have a great day. Thank you.
