3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, we're going to go
4 ahead and get started. Well, I'd first like to thank
5 you for participating in ABCA's public roll call
6 hearings via the WebEx platform provided by the D.C.
7 Office of Open Government.

8 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the
9 roll call hearing as the Board's agent. There is one
10 case on the calendar today, this is the matter of
11 Transmission, case number 26-PRO-00047, 618
12 Productions, LLC, 1353 H Street Northeast, number
13 ABRA-13331.

14 This is a Retailer Class CT Tavern for a
15 substantial change, there is a request to change the
16 hours. The proposed hours of operation and live
17 entertainment are Sunday through Saturday, 12:00 a.m.
18 to 12:00 a.m., 24 hours operation. Proposed hours for
19 sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages
20 are Sunday through Thursday, 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.,
21 Friday and Saturday, 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m.

22 Is anyone present on behalf of the
23 Applicant?

24 MS. WILENSKY: Yes, I am.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. If you would
state your name and spell it for the record, please?

1 MS. WILENSKY: Sure, my name is Claire
2 Wilensky, that is C-L-A-I-R-E, Wilensky, W-I-L-E-N-S-
3 K-Y.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And
5 on behalf of the ANC?

6 MR. GIERTZ: That would be me, Jeff
7 Giertz, J-E-F-F G-I-E-R-T-Z, and I'm the chair of ANC
8 6A's Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Committee.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Commissioner
10 Giertz, ANC 6A does have standing as a protestant. We
11 need to set a date for a mediation, a status hearing,
12 and a protest hearing. I'm going to give you the
13 dates for the status and protest hearing first, the
14 status hearing is scheduled for July 29 at 10:30 a.m.,
15 the protest hearing is set for September 16 at 1:30.

16 I will give you the next available day for
17 mediation. The next available day is Monday, June 15,
18 at either 11:30 or 1:30. That's Monday, June 15, at
19 11:30 or 1:30.

20 MR. GIERTZ: Either of those times would
21 work on my end.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you,
23 Commissioner. Ms. Wilensky, what about you?

24 MS. WILENSKY: Those would work. The
25 preference would be for the 1:30 time, but if the
earlier one is better, that's okay.

1 MS. FLETCHER: We can do 1:30, I'll
2 schedule the mediation for June 15 at 1:30 p.m. Any
3 questions at all?

4 (No audible response.)

5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well --

6 MS. WILENSKY: I don't think so.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Oh. Thank you for coming,
8 the roll call hearing in this matter is concluded.
9 See you on Monday, June 15, thank you.

10 MS. WILENSKY: I guess my one question is,
11 will that be on a WebEx as well?

12 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, it will. That will be
13 -- just for the court reporter, who's speaking right
14 now?

15 (No audible response.)

16 MS. FLETCHER: Who was just speaking?

17 MS. WILENSKY: Oh, sorry, Claire from
18 Transmission.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very much.
20 Yes, it'll be via WebEx, just like today.

21 MS. WILENSKY: Okay, thank you.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well, thank you very
23 much for coming and I'll see you soon.
