The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
We're at the end of our morning agenda, and so let us now go to our morning calendar, so let us now go to our Legal Agenda. The first matter on our Legal Agenda, it's an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing for Case Number 22-CMP-00017, Shake Shack, License Number 104724. And the offer in compromise for charge one, providing a false statement, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-766; there will be a fine of \$500.00 payable in 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. For charge two, no ABC manager, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-701; there will be a fine of $\$ 500.00$ payable in 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board approves this offer in compromise. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I second. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has second the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short.

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato. MEMBER CATO: (No audible response.) CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett. MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen. MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis. MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr. Anderson. I agree. The matter passed 6-0-0. Number two, review of an offer in compromise of a hearing dated June 2, 2022 for Case Number 2022-- I'm sorry -- Case Number 22-251-00012, Mirror Lounge, License Number 111950. And the offer in compromise -- this is a long one, but $I$ have to read this in the record -- but the offer in compromise for charge one, the OIC terms are as follows: Prior to the Board lifting the suspension of the ABC license, respondent shall pay a fine of $\$ 2,000.00$ for violating D.C.

Code Section 25-823(a)(2) by allowing the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose.

Number 2, security cameras; prior to the Board lifting the suspension of the ABC license, respondent shall ensure all installed cameras are operational and that the footage from all individual cameras are immediately available upon request of the Metropolitan Police Department or ABRA, and ABRA shall inspect the camera system and provide a written report on their status.

Number 3, updated security plan; prior to the Board lifting the suspension, the establishment will revise its security plan under section procedures for handling violent incidents by adding the phrase "if MPD officers arrive at the establishment in response to reported acts of violence, disorderly, or unlawful conduct occurring in the establishment, the ABC manager, owner, and all employees on site will immediately assist the MPD officers as requested and notify ABRA of the incident.

Number 4, Board Order Number 2022-228; prior to the lifting of the suspension, respondent must also comply with the following
requirements of Board Order Number 2022-228, issued on May 16, 2022.

Number 4A, barring action; respondent shall execute and maintain a barring notice against James Burwell (ph) as ordered by the Board. The establishment shall provide a copy of the executed barring notice to the Board and enforce the barring notice whenever Mr. Burwell presents himself to the establishment. The establishment may also apply to the Board to have the provision lifted upon the showing that Mr. Burwell doesn't pose a threat to the security of the establishment.

4B, criminal background checks; no employee or person providing security services shall be permitted to work at the establishment until he or she has undergone a criminal background check whenever conducted by the establishment or a third party. Prior to the Board lifting the suspension of the ABC license, the establishment shall conduct at least one criminal background check of all current employees if it has not done so already. The establishment shall provide an affidavit listing all employees and affirm that a criminal
background check has been conducted. In addition, the establishment shall provide adequate proof that it paid for and used a criminal background check service, e.g., proof of payment or contract. No submission of the results of background checks to the Board is required.

4C, reopening training; the establishment shall provide security training to all current personnel and the security staff to include the establishment's security plant and procedure for reporting incidents of violence or injury to the ABC manager, security supervisor, or other appropriate authority. All security persons shall be trained in security procedures prior to commencing work. On an annual basis, all security personnel shall receive a refresher training on the security plan. The establishment shall provide an affidavit stating that all security receive training and the date and time such training occurred.

That is the offer in compromise. I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board approves this offer in compromise. Is there a second?

allowed the establishment to be sued for unlawful purpose, patron argument outside of establishment, D.C. Code Section -- the authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(2); this charge has been dismissed.

Charge two, exceeded interior occupancy, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-762(b)(1); a warning will be issued in this case.

Charge three, sold alcohol to an intoxicated patron, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-081(a)(2); this charge is dismissed.

Charge number 4, failed to post window lettering, - D.C. Code Section 25711(d); there will be a fine of $\$ 250.00$ payable within 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge number 5, interfered with an ABRA investigator -- investigation; statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(5); there will be a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board approve this offer in compromise. Is there a

Charge number 2, furnished a false document, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-835(b). There will be a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the OIC, and if payment is not made within the 120 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board approves this offer in compromise. Is there a second?
