CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

We're at the end of our morning agenda, and so let us now go to our morning calendar, so let us now go to our Legal Agenda. The first matter on our Legal Agenda, it's an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing for Case Number 22-CMP-00017, Shake Shack, License Number 104724. And the offer in compromise for charge one, providing a false statement, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-766; there will be a fine of \$500.00 payable in 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. For charge two, no ABC manager, statutory authority D.C. Code Section 25-701; there will be a fine of \$500.00 payable in 120 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board approves this offer in compromise. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has second the motion. We'll now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Short.

1 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short. I agree.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato?

12 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis. I

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.

15 Anderson. I agree. The matter passed 6-0-0.

16 Number two, review of an offer in
17 compromise of a hearing dated June 2, 2022 for
18 Case Number 2022 -- I'm sorry -- Case Number 22-
19 251-00012, Mirror Lounge, License Number 111950.
20 And the offer in compromise -- this is a long
21 one, but I have to read this in the record -- but
22 the offer in compromise for charge one, the OIC
23 terms are as follows: Prior to the Board lifting
24 the suspension of the ABC license, respondent
25 shall pay a fine of \$2,000.00 for violating D.C.

1 Code Section 25-823(a)(2) by allowing the
2 establishment to be used for unlawful purpose.

3 Number 2, security cameras; prior to
4 the Board lifting the suspension of the ABC
5 license, respondent shall ensure all installed
6 cameras are operational and that the footage from
7 all individual cameras are immediately available
8 upon request of the Metropolitan Police
9 Department or ABRA, and ABRA shall inspect the
10 camera system and provide a written report on
11 their status.

12 Number 3, updated security plan; prior
13 to the Board lifting the suspension, the
14 establishment will revise its security plan under
15 section procedures for handling violent incidents
16 by adding the phrase "if MPD officers arrive at
17 the establishment in response to reported acts of
18 violence, disorderly, or unlawful conduct
19 occurring in the establishment, the ABC manager,
20 owner, and all employees on site will immediately
21 assist the MPD officers as requested and notify
22 ABRA of the incident.

23 Number 4, Board Order Number 2022-228;
24 prior to the lifting of the suspension,
25 respondent must also comply with the following

1 requirements of Board Order Number 2022-228,
2 issued on May 16, 2022.

3 Number 4A, barring action; respondent
4 shall execute and maintain a barring notice
5 against James Burwell (ph) as ordered by the
6 Board. The establishment shall provide a copy of
7 the executed barring notice to the Board and
8 enforce the barring notice whenever Mr. Burwell
9 presents himself to the establishment. The
10 establishment may also apply to the Board to have
11 the provision lifted upon the showing that Mr.
12 Burwell doesn't pose a threat to the security of
13 the establishment.

14 4B, criminal background checks; no
15 employee or person providing security services
16 shall be permitted to work at the establishment
17 until he or she has undergone a criminal
18 background check whenever conducted by the
19 establishment or a third party. Prior to the
20 Board lifting the suspension of the ABC license,
21 the establishment shall conduct at least one
22 criminal background check of all current
23 employees if it has not done so already. The
24 establishment shall provide an affidavit listing
25 all employees and affirm that a criminal

1 background check has been conducted. In
2 addition, the establishment shall provide
3 adequate proof that it paid for and used a
4 criminal background check service, e.g., proof of
5 payment or contract. No submission of the
6 results of background checks to the Board is
7 required.

8 4C, reopening training; the
9 establishment shall provide security training to
10 all current personnel and the security staff to
11 include the establishment's security plan and
12 procedure for reporting incidents of violence or
13 injury to the ABC manager, security supervisor,
14 or other appropriate authority. All security
15 persons shall be trained in security procedures
16 prior to commencing work. On an annual basis,
17 all security personnel shall receive a refresher
18 training on the security plan. The establishment
19 shall provide an affidavit stating that all
20 security receive training and the date and time
21 such training occurred.

22 That is the offer in compromise. I,
23 therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board
24 approves this offer in compromise. Is there a
25 second?

24 D'Italia, License Number 109613. And the offer

25 in compromise for that case is charge one,

1 allowed the establishment to be sued for unlawful
2 purpose, patron argument outside of
3 establishment, D.C. Code Section -- the
4 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(2); this
5 charge has been dismissed.

6 Charge two, exceeded interior
7 occupancy, statutory authority D.C. Code Section
8 25-762(b)(1); a warning will be issued in this
9 case.

10 Charge three, sold alcohol to an
11 intoxicated patron, statutory authority D.C. Code
12 Section 25-081(a)(2); this charge is dismissed.

13 Charge number 4, failed to post window
14 lettering, - D.C. Code Section 25711(d); there
15 will be a fine of \$250.00 payable within 120
16 days, or the license shall be suspended
17 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

18 Charge number 5, interfered with an
19 ABRA investigator -- investigation; statutory
20 authority D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(5); there
21 will be a fine of \$1,000.00 payable within 120
22 days, or the license shall be suspended
23 indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I,
24 therefore, make a motion that the ABC Board
25 approve this offer in compromise. Is there a

1 second?

25 false or misleading statement, statutory

1 authority D.C. Section 25-120(i)(a)(iii). There
2 will be a fine of \$1,000.00 payable within 120
3 days of the Board accepting the OIC, and if
4 payment is not made within 120 days, the license
5 will be suspended until payment is received.

6 Charge number 2, furnished a false
7 document, statutory authority D.C. Code Section
8 25-835(b). There will be a fine of \$1,000.00
9 payable within 120 days of the Board accepting
10 the OIC, and if payment is not made within the
11 120 days, the license will be suspended until the
12 fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion
13 that the ABC Board approves this offer in
14 compromise. Is there a second?
