3	MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4	calendar is Apero DC. This is Case number 25-
5	PRO-00047, GothWine Limited Liability Company,
6	2622 P Street Northwest, License number ABRA
7	116925. This is a Retailer Class CR Restaurant
8	for a license renewal.
9	My name's LaVerne Fletcher,
10	conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
11	Agent. Is anyone present on behalf of Apero DC?
12	MS. BENCHIMOL: Yes, ma'am. I'm Elli
13	Benchimol, owner and licensee for Apero GothWine.
14	MS. FLETCHER: If you would just
15	pronounce your name one more time? I have the
16	spelling. If you could just pronounce it again?
17	MS. BENCHIMOL: Elli Benchimol.
18	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Now we have
19	Elizabeth. What are you going by?
20	MS. BENCHIMOL: It's just shortened.
21	It's the same name, sorry. My legal name's
22	Elizabeth. Thanks.
23	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So we'll go
24	with that. Is anyone present on behalf of ANC
25	2E?

1 MS. LOHSE: Hi. Gwendolyn Lohse, 2 Chair of ANC 2E, Commissioner for ANC 2E 06. And 3 it's Gwendolyn, G-W-E-N-D-O-L-Y-N, Lohse, L-O-H-4 S-E. And I'm the Commissioner that's 5 representing this as assigned by ANC 2E. 6 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, 7 Commissioner Lohse. We also have a couple of 8 individuals. Is Neel Lund present? 9 MR. LUND: Yes, ma'am. 10 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Lund, is, thank 11 you. Is Ms. Makhbuba present? 12 Yes. MS. LUND: Here. 13 MR. LUND: Makhbuba, yes. 14 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. 15 Now you filed your protest as abutting property 16 owners. 17 MR. LUND: Correct. 18 MS. FLETCHER: According to the DC 19 Geographic Information System your properties 20 actually do not abut. They're not touching. 21 There is a street between them, which means that 2.2 the properties are not touching in any way. 23 MR. LUND: Ma'am, the, you mean the 24 back vard. So, where the summer garden is. So 25 they're actually right against each other.

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1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. That doesn't 2 come through in the DC Geographic Information 3 System. According to it the properties that you 4 actually live in do not abut. 5 I understand what you're saying. But 6 you're saying that your properties abut on the 7 outside where the summer garden --8 MR. LUND: Exactly. 9 (Simultaneous speaking) 10 MS. FLETCHER: -- your property. 11 MR. LUND: Yes. Exactly. 12 And so what you're MS. FLETCHER: 13 going to need to do is provide us with evidence 14 to that effect. According, the DC Geographic 15 System does not show that your properties abut in 16 that way. Although based on what you're saying 17 they actually do. 18 MS. LOHSE: Ms. Fletcher, can I -- I 19 don't want to interrupt. But based on the --20 MS. FLETCHER: Just a second. Just a 21 second. Just a second. 2.2 MS. LOHSE: Okay. 23 MS. FLETCHER: Who's speaking? 24 Gwendolyn Lohse, ANC 2E. MS. LOHSE: 25 MS. Oh. FLETCHER: Yes,

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1 Commissioner. 2 MS. LOHSE: They signed the 3 settlement. So I would think that that is, as an 4 abutting property --5 MR. LUND: Yes. 6 MS. LOHSE: -- neighbor. So I would think that would be evidence enough for ABCA, 7 8 that they are abutting, since they signed as, the 9 settlement in that role. 10 MR. LUND: Yes. 11 MS. FLETCHER: So you're saying that 12 in this particular case a settlement agreement 13 has been signed? Or was that in some previous 14 case? 15 MS. LOHSE: It existing was an 16 settlement agreement. 17 MS. FLETCHER: I mean for this case 18 that we're here for today? 19 MS. LOHSE: Correct. 20 MS. FLETCHER: Nobody told -- So 21 you're saying --2.2 (Audio interference) 23 MS. FLETCHER: So you're saying that 24 Mr. and Mrs. Lund have entered into a settlement 25 agreement to resolve the protest that we're here

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1 about today? 2 (Audio interference) 3 MS. LOHSE: I can't hear. I'm sorry. 4 MS. FLETCHER: Can you excuse me for 5 one minute? Ms. Bryan, that's B-R-Y-A-N for the 6 court reporter. Can you mute yourself, please? 7 I hear a conversation going on in the background. 8 Commissioner Lohse, what were you 9 saying? 10 I don't know what the MS. LOHSE: 11 records you are referring to are. But --12 MS. FLETCHER: Yes. So what --13 MS. LOHSE: -- I'm seeing that they 14 are referenced in a ABCA document as abutting 15 neighbors. So to try to save people time, 16 because I think this is a dialogue between the 17 applicant and the people with the agreement to 18 update the agreement. It is a protest of an 19 existing agreement. 20 So we're here about MS. FLETCHER: 21 Apero DC. What I'm asking is whether or not 2.2 there's a settlement agreement between Neel and 23 Makhbuba? 24 Yes, there is. They MS. BENCHIMOL: 25 already signed the settlement agreement. This is

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Elli --1 2 MR. LUND: Yes. 3 MS. BENCHIMOL: -- Benchimol. 4 MS. FLETCHER: So you've already 5 resolved this matter with Apero? 6 MS. BENCHIMOL: We're about to. 7 MS. LOHSE: We're protesting to get, 8 in order to --MS. FLETCHER: Well, who's speaking? 9 Who's speaking right now? 10 11 MS. Sorry. ANC 2E is LOHSE: 12 speaking. Commissioner Lohse. 13 MS. FLETCHER: The name, who, the 14 name of the person speaking. 15 MS. LOHSE: Commissioner Lohse. 16 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Commissioner 17 Lohse, for some reason I can't see your mouth 18 moving. Okay. So can you say what you were 19 saying again? 20 We're protesting in order MS. LOHSE: 21 to update and discuss the current settlement, 2.2 which is within our right as signers. 23 MS. FLETCHER: So we're here today to 24 determine who has standing as protestants. And 25 so --

1	MS. LOHSE: Correct.
2	MS. FLETCHER: at this point for
3	the purpose of roll call there is no agreement.
4	So we're only here to determine who has standing
5	as protestants.
6	And based on what you're saying,
7	Commissioner Lohse, Mr. and Mrs. Lund you believe
8	had standing because they entered into a prior
9	agreement with Apero DC as abutting property
10	owners. Is that what you're saying?
11	MS. LOHSE: Correct.
12	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Lund, that's
13	correct?
14	MR. LUND: Correct, correct, correct.
15	MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Benchimol.
16	MS. BENCHIMOL: Yes, ma'am.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Is that correct?
18	MS. BENCHIMOL: That is correct. We
19	have a signed settlement agreement that I have
20	been following.
21	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And in that
22	settlement agreement the Lunds are noted as
23	abutting property owners?
24	MS. BENCHIMOL: Yes. Against the
25	summer garden in the back, yes.

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1 MS. FLETCHER: So is that indicated 2 in the settlement agreement? 3 MS. BENCHIMOL: Yes, it is. 4 MS. FLETCHER: Because you both 5 agree? Because you both agree? 6 MS. BENCHIMOL: We both agree that 7 they are abutting to the back summer garden, yes. 8 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Because you 9 both agree, as does Commissioner Lohse, I am 10 going to grant standing to Mr. and Mrs. Lund as 11 abutting property owners in this case. 12 I'11 verify by checking the 13 settlement agreement following the roll call 14 Ιf hearing. you're not there as abutting 15 property owners I'm going to get back with you. 16 Okay? 17 MR. LUND: Perfect. Thank you. 18 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. ANC 19 2E does have standing as a protestant. Give me 20 one second to make a note here. Okay. We need 21 to set a date for the status hearing, protest 2.2 hearing, and the mediation. 23 MS. BENCHIMOL: Can I just clarify? 24 Are they protesting my actual license, or --25 MS. FLETCHER: Who's --

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1 MS. BENCHIMOL: -- updating an 2 agreement? 3 MS. FLETCHER: Who's speaking, 4 please? 5 BENCHIMOL: This is Elli MS. б Benchimol. 7 MS. FLETCHER: And what's your 8 question? 9 MS. BENCHIMOL: Are we protesting the 10 current agreement in place or the actual liquor 11 license? 12 No. The protest is MS. FLETCHER: 13 filed against the application to renew the 14 license. 15 MS. BENCHIMOL: Okay. Thank you. 16 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. We 17 need to set a date for a status hearing, protest 18 hearing, and mediation. I'll give you the dates 19 for the status and protest hearing first. 20 The status hearing is scheduled for 21 July 23rd, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. 2.2 MS. BENCHIMOL: I apologize. This is 23 Elli Benchimol. I am out of the country at that 24 time. 25 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Ms. Benchimol,

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1 when do you return? 2 MS. BENCHIMOL: I'll be back on the 3 27th. 4 MS. FLETCHER: What you're going to 5 need to do is petition the ABC Board. Excuse me 6 one second. I'm hearing a lot of noise in the 7 background here. 8 Unfortunately I can't identify the 9 names of the individuals because I only have telephone numbers. If you have any noise in your 10 11 background please place yourself on mute. Thank 12 you. 13 Ms. Fletcher, this is MS. LOHSE: 14 Commissioner Lohse. If Apero and the protestants 15 can agree on a time for roll call? I don't want 16 scheduling issues. 17 I know people have a lot of travel. 18 And I heard she's not available until she's back 19 Should we communicate together for on the 27th. 20 some proposed times? 21 MS. FLETCHER: What you're going to 2.2 need to do together, Commissioner, is submit a 23 petition to the ABC Board to reschedule the date 24 of the status hearing. You may do that jointly. 25 And they will give you the next available day for

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1 a status hearing.

2	I've just made a note that that
3	request is coming. And that the applicant will
4	be out of the country until the 27th
5	MS. LOHSE: Thank you.
6	MS. FLETCHER: of May. You're
7	welcome. So the status hearing, just so that you
8	know, it is scheduled for July 23 or 27th. But
9	you are going to petition the Board to change
10	that to a different date.
11	The protest hearing is scheduled for
12	September 10, September 10 at 1:30 p.m. I'm
13	going to give you the next available day for
14	mediation.
15	The next available day for mediation
16	is Thursday, July 3rd. If that's good we can
17	look at times between 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
18	If not I will move to the following week.
19	MS. BENCHIMOL: This is Elli
20	Benchimol. And that day works fine for me, any
21	time.
22	MR. LUND: Same for us.
23	MS. FLETCHER: Is that the Lunds?
24	MR. LUND: Yes. Sorry, yes. The
25	Lunds, same for us.

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1	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
2	Commissioner Lohse?
3	MS. LOHSE: Same for me. Thank you.
4	MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome. I am
5	setting mediation for Thursday, July 3rd at 10:30
6	a.m. And I will send you WebEx invitations to
7	attend.
8	If you're able to resolve this matter
9	prior to that just let us know and we'll cancel
10	the mediation. And if the Board approves the
11	settlement agreement then the status hearing and
12	the protest hearing will be cancelled as well.
13	MS. BENCHIMOL: Thank you very much.
14	MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.
15	Okay. If there's nothing more the roll call
16	hearing in this matter is concluded.
