The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Thee next case on the
4 calendar is Seymours Liquors. This is Case No.
5 24-PRO-00052, Jackson Family Liquor Store, Inc.,
6 5579 Central Avenue SE, License No. ABRA-112-303.
7 This is a Retailer Class A liquor store for a
8 license renewal.

9 The protest issues are adverse impact
10 on peace, order, and quiet, and residential
11 parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

12 My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting
13 the roll call hearing as the Board's Agent.

14 Is anyone present on behalf of Seymour
15 Liquors?

16 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 7E?

17 Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 7C?

18 MR. HOLMES: This is Commissioner Chair
19 Antawan Holmes, A-N-T-A-W-A-N H-O-L M-E-S.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Mr.
21 Holmes.

22 MR. HOLMES: Good morning.

23 MS. BROWN: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher.
24 This is Commissioner Carrie N. Brown, C-A-R-R-I-
25 E, middle initial N, last name B-R-O-W-N.

1 MS. FLETCHER: I thought I saw you, Ms.
2 Brown, good morning.

3 MS. BROWN: Good morning, how are you?

4 MS. FLETCHER: I'm doing fine, thank
5 you.

6 MS. BROWN: Good. Good to get
7 together.

8 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 7C does have
9 standing as a Protestant.

10 Mr. Holmes, I need you to confirm that
11 a quorum was present. I saw in your protest
12 letter that seven of nine Commissioners were
13 present.

14 MR. HOLMES: Yes, ma'am.

15 MS. FLETCHER: I already know that it
16 constitutes a quorum. I just need you to say it.

17 MR. HOLMES: Yes, it constitutes a
18 quorum.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And, you state
20 that in your future protest letters, and we go
21 through this little exercise.

22 MR. HOLMES: What do you want me to
23 say, you want to say that five of nine
24 Commissioners is an effective quorum for custody

25 MS. FLETCHER: No, I --

1 MR. HOLMES: I'm not trying to humor
2 you.

3 MS. FLETCHER: -- yeah, no I just saw
4 you, I just want you to add that seven, I just
5 want you to add the quorum request.

6 MR. HOLMES: Oh, okay. I did add it to
7 my newer ones.

8 MS. FLETCHER: I know. I know that.

9 MR. HOLMES: Okay.

10 MS. FLETCHER: I did notice that.

11 MR. HOLMES: All right. Just making
12 sure, I thought I did that.

13 MS. FLETCHER: The Applicant is not
14 present, and so the application is dismissed.
15 ANC 7E is not present, and the protest filed by
16 ANC 7E is dismissed.

17 Mr. Holmes and Ms. Brown, a Board
18 order will go out dismissing the application, and
19 ANC 7E you'll receive a copy of the Board order.
20 And, if either one of those parties seek
21 reinstatement I will let you know, but we'll keep
22 you posted from this point on. But, at this
23 point the application is dismissed.

24 MR. HOLMES: Absolutely.

25 MS. FLETCHER: ANC 7E is dismissed, and

1 thank you for coming.

2 I do believe the rest of the cases on
3 the calendar are yours today, so you are going to
4 stay?

5 MR. HOLMES: Yes.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. The roll call
7 hearing in the matter of Seymour's Liquors is
8 concluded.
