5	is Case Number 24-CIT-00696, Giovanni's Trattu,
6	License Number 126137.
7	Good afternoon, Mr. Orellana. Can
8	you please elevate the rights of the Government,
9	the Government, any witness it might have, and
10	the Licensee in this case.
11	MR. ORELLANA: Sure. Sophia Mietus,
12	your access has been elevated. Brianna Graham

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good 6 afternoon, ma'am. The Licensee is not here. Is 7 the Government prepared to move forward ex parte? 8 MS. MIETUS: Members of the Board,

9 the District actually requests that the Board 10 find in its favor based upon the evidence in the 11 record without the presentation of any testimony 12 or further evidence for two reasons.

First, this Board has sufficient evidence to consider the charges in the show cause because the case report for this matter, 2024-CIT-696, is automatically in evidence and part of the Board's record under 23 DCMR Section 18 1713.10.

That case report will show that Giovanni's Trattu failed to timely file their quarterly statement for the period of April 2024 to June 2024.

That conduct as we know is a violation of DC Code Section 25-113(b)(2)(a) and 25 23 DCMR Section 1207.1.

1 Second, Giovanni's Trattu has not 2 made any effort to contest the show cause notice. 3 This Licensee has received the case report and 4 the show cause notice yet did not appear to 5 contest that here or ask the Board to reschedule 6 this hearing. 7 So their failure to appear should be 8 treated as a concession to liability and given 9 the uncontroverted evidence the District asks 10 that this Board find in its favor and apply the 11 maximum penalty consistent with DC Code Section 12 25 - 830. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well you kind 14 of jumped the gun a little bit, so just let me 15 back up a little bit. 16 Based on presentation it either 17 appears to me that the Government is prepared to move forward ex parte, so, therefore, pursuant to 18 19 DC Official Code Section 25-447 the Board has the 20 authority to proceed ex parte where the Licensee 21 waives a hearing or fails to appear unless a 2.2 hearing is extended for good and sufficient 23 cause. 24 The Board's record reflects that the 25 Licensee was promptly served on April 15th and

1 seeing no Licensee here today and having no good 2 insufficient cause to extend the hearing the 3 Board will proceed with the show cause hearing. 4 I know that the Government's position 5 is to move forward, but what I will just ask you 6 to do, ma'am, you are correct that the case 7 report is a part of the Board's record and you 8 are correct that in your assertion that since the 9 Licensee has failed to appear today that they have conceded the facts in this case. 10 11 Just one more time at this junction, 12 ma'am, just repeat what it is that you are asking 13 the Board to do. 14 MS. MIETUS: Yes, of course. Members 15 of the Board, Giovanni's Trattu failed to file 16 their April 2024 to June 2024 quarterly statement 17 and the District is here to ask the Board to 18 assess the maximum penalty for that violation, 19 which is under DC Code Section 25-830. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 21 Thank you, ma'am. 2.2 MS. MIETUS: Thank you. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Graham, 24 thank you for being here today. Your testimony 25 is not required, ma'am.
