3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so since we
4 are now at the end of our calendar for the day,
5 let me now do our legal agenda for alcohol. The
6 first matter on our legal agenda for alcohol is a
7 review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a
8 hearing dated June 6, 2024, for case number
9 23CIT-00782, Chupacabra, license number 092662.

10 The offer in compromise is as follows:

11 Charge 1, fail to file the required
12 quarterly statement, second tier violation,
13 statutory authority DC code section 25113B2A.
14 There is a \$250 fine paid within 30 days or the
15 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
16 fine has been paid and that they need to submit
17 an independent quarterly statement if they have
18 not been submitted.

19 I therefore make a motion that the
20 offer in compromise be accepted. Is there a
21 second?

1 that we stead refer this for a show cause. Is
2 there a second?

3 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant, I second the
4 motion.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
6 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
7 vote.

8 Mr. Short?

9 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?

11 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Anderson,
13 I agree. The matter passes 3-0.

14 Our next -- it's a review of the North
15 Shaw moratorium on emergency and proposed
16 rulemaking. This is what the board is proposing.
17 The board notes that the board is voting to have
18 a notice of emergency and proposed rulemaking for
19 the North Shaw moratorium on emergency and
20 proposed rulemaking.

21 Specifically, what the board is
22 proposing is that these rules will enact a
23 moratorium on an emergency basis and proposed
24 basis that prohibits the following for a period
25 of three years. I'm sorry, let me start over.

1 The proposed emergency rulemaking
2 would create a new moratorium zone for three
3 years that would extend approximately 600 feet in
4 all directions from 1909 9th Street Northwest,
5 which is the location of North Noah Naol D.C.
6 LLC, Sound Bar, retailer class CT license
7 12228664.

8 The moratorium would prevent No. 1,
9 new retailer class CN and D and nightclub
10 license. No. 2, it would prevent new retailer
11 class CT and DT tavern license. No. 3, would
12 prevent new retailer class CX and DX multi-
13 purpose license.

14 No. 4, it would prevent new
15 entertainment endorsements for any on-premise
16 licensed restaurant or tavern to offer
17 entertainment with a cover charge or facilities
18 for dancing.

19 No. 5, prevent modification to an
20 entertainment endorsement for any unpremised
21 licensed restaurant or tavern to add
22 entertainment, a cover charge, or facilities for
23 dancing.

24 No. 6, prevent a licensed nightclub
25 multi-purpose facility or restaurant or tavern

1 with an entertainment endorsement from
2 transferring from a location outside of the
3 moratorium area to a location inside the
4 moratorium area.

5 And, No. 7. Prevents the board from
6 granting within the moratorium area a change of
7 license class application for a class CN, DN, CT,
8 DT, CX multipurpose facility or DX multipurpose
9 retailer's license.

10 I therefore make a motion that the
11 board approve the North Shaw Moratorium Zone
12 Emergency and Proposed Rulemaking. Is there a
13 second?

14 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
16 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
17 Mr. Short?

18 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?

20 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
22 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed 3-0.

23 The next vote is a vote on the review
24 of the Langdon Park Moratorium Zone Emergency
25 Rulemaking. The board will be voting today to

1 adopt the Langdon Park Moratorium Zone Notice of
2 Emergency Rulemaking for it to be effective
3 today. This emergency rule will remain in effect
4 for 120 days, expiring on November 10, 2024.

5 Basically, the board found it
6 necessary to take the further emergency action to
7 extend the Langdon Park Moratorium Zone because
8 the board finds it necessary to extend the
9 current moratorium until we have had an
10 opportunity to review the public hearing that we
11 recently had.

12 So, therefore, I make a motion that
13 the board passes the Langdon Park Zone Emergency
14 Rulemaking. Is there a second?

15 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant, I second the
16 motion.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
18 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
19 vote.

20 Mr. Short?

21 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?

23 MR. GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

1 We now move to our medical cannabis,

6 license number 127801.

7 I make a motion that we approve this
8 agreement. Is there a second?

9 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second the
10 motion.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
12 seconded the motion. We'll have a roll call
13 vote. Mr. Short?

14 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
